Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival, Giza Pyramids and Saqqara Necropolis

Upon arrival at Cairo international airport, you will find our representative waiting for you at the terminal to transfer you by a private vehicle to the hotel in Giza, you can leave your luggage and now you will be ready to begin our 3 Days Cairo Stopover Wheelchair Accessible tour package to explore the amazing trips in Cairo starting by visiting the <u>Pyramids of Giza</u>, where you can see the most incredible Pyramids of Egypt. The Great Pyramid of King Cheops is a distinctive symbol of Egypt and the last of the ancient Seven Wonders of the World. It is located on the Giza Plateau near the greater city of Cairo and was built for a period of twenty years during the reign of the <u>fourth dynasty</u> King Khufu (2589-2566 BC, also known as Cheops). You will have the opportunity to have an optional camel ride in Giza Pyramids for 1 hour.

Now we will move to see the <u>Valley Temple</u> of King <u>Chephren</u> during the <u>tour of the Giza pyramids</u>, and his statue which is known as the Great <u>Sphinx</u>, a man-headed lion that symbolizes power and intelligence.

Transfer to see the Step Pyramid of King Djoser (or Zoser), a 3rd dynasty monument within the necropolis of Saqqara, Egypt, northwest of the ancient capital of Egypt, Memphis. The 6-story 4-sided structure is the first colossal stone building in Egypt. You will also have the possibility to enter one of the pyramids of Saqqara, the Pyramid of Teti and the <u>tomb of Kagemni</u>, one of the tombs of the

nobles in Saqqara, Kagemni was the son-in-law of King Teti who ruled Egypt during the 6th dynasty of the <u>old kingdom</u>. You will see amazing wall inscriptions for different kinds of animals, fish, and birds in offering and hunting scenes that are considered the finest examples of art in ancient Egypt.

Transfer back to the hotel after having a tasty lunch meal in one of the great restaurants, check-in, and overnight in Cairo.

Day 2: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El Khalili Bazaar

After your delicious breakfast is served at the hotel, you will meet your licensed tour guide to start your amazing Cairo city tour by visiting the unimaginable <u>Egyptian Museum tour</u>, discover the famous artifacts in Egypt at the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in <u>Tahrir Square</u>, where you can see many artifacts from different periods, on a guided tour for almost 2 hours, you will see the gigantic statues of Ramses II, the golden mask and the funerary collections of the king Tutankhamen and other precious artifacts.

Transfer to the area of Old Cairo to start your <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u> to the Hanging Church that was constructed over the ruins of the Roman fortress of Babylon, discover the place where the holy family took refuge inside the cavern Church of St. Sergius, and explore one of the oldest Jewish temples in the Middle-East, the Synagogue of Ben Ezra.

Have your yummy lunch meal and have an amazing visit to a famous market in the Islamic Cairo area, Egypt. The bazaar district is one of Cairo's main attractions for both tourists and Egyptians. It also houses many Egyptian craftsmen and workshops involved in the production of traditional crafts and souvenirs while you can enjoy the best Cairo walking tours, drink a tea-mint in a local cafe, or just wander around the area to see the monumental Islamic buildings.

Back to the hotel after your excursions in Cairo are done, overnight in the Cairo hotel.
