Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Upon arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), the Cairo Top Tours tour manager will be waiting for you inside your terminal holding a signboard displaying your name. He will accompany you by a private air-conditioned elegant vehicle to your hotel in Giza. When you reach the hotel you will settle in your room after our representative assists you with a smooth check-in and make sure to revise the itinerary of your Cairo and Alexandria Wheelchair Accessible Tour Package for all pick-up times.

Overnight in Cairo.

Welcome Drink

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

Enjoy your delicious breakfast in the early morning at your hotel in Cairo. And then, our representative will meet you to start your Giza pyramids tour, we will transfer you to visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops in Giza necropolis that was built 4500 years ago. During our Egypt tours for the disabled, you will have some free time to go inside if you wish or to take some photos of the enormous structure while your tour guide tells you the story of the pyramids.

See the second Pyramid of [king Chephren](#) who is the 2nd reigning son of Cheops, he built his pyramid in Giza slightly smaller than his father's in respect. as well as the famous Sphinx which is the largest among the sphinxes in Egypt. You will also see the third Pyramid of king Mycerinus of the 4th dynasty from above the high plateau, where you will have the availability to enjoy a camel ride in the Giza Pyramids (optional activity) to take amazing photos.

Transfer to see the Great Sphinx in Giza which stood as a guardian to the whole necropolis, it was carved from one stone 73 meters long in a figure of a lion with a man's head, smart like a human and as strong as the lion.

Your next stop is to visit the Valley Temple of King Chephren which is one of the oldest temples in Egypt and is located right in front of the Sphinx, the temple was principally built to perform the ritual known as the opening of the mouth for King Chephren so that his Mummy can eat, drink and talk properly in the afterlife.

You will be transferred for about 35 minutes drive to visit the open-air museum in the ancient city of Memphis to explore the treasures and masterpieces that remain from the oldest capital city of the Egyptian empire since the time of King Menes 5000 years ago after the unification of the two lands and starting the 1st dynasty of Egypt history. Memphis was the capital of Egypt during the Old Kingdom and a very important city during the Middle Kingdom and the New Kingdom all the way to the Greco-Roman era of ancient Egypt history.

Transfer to Saqqara necropolis, one of the richest and oldest archeological sites in the world, and the home of 11 royal pyramids and many Mastaba tombs for the high officials, aristocrats, and nobles as well as the relatives of the Pharaohs of ancient Egypt. You will see the Step Pyramid, which is the oldest pyramid built by the famous architect Imhotep to King Djoser and it is considered the first stone building in the world.

The tour includes the entrance to the [pyramid of King Teti](#) which is inscribed from the inside with hieroglyphs and Cartouches of the kings, the Cartouches are oval or elongated confining a group of Egyptian hieroglyphs (symbols), typically representing the name and title of a king. We will also take you to visit one of the tombs of the nobles built in the form of the Mastaba tomb and decorated with colorful scenes of daily life in ancient Egypt.

Now you can rest and enjoy your lunch in a local restaurant in the village of Saqqara then we will move back to the hotel after finishing your exciting tours in Giza.

Day 3: Egypt Museum, Coptic and Islamic Cairo Tours

Have your breakfast meal served at the hotel and get ready to resume your Wheelchair Accessible Tours in Egypt. Today your licensed tour guide will take you to visit the Egyptian Museum, which is considered one of the most popular museums in the world because of its large quantity of Egyptian antiques displayed on two floors, and the most interesting among them are shown separately, the royal treasure of the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen.

Move to [the Citadel of Saladin](#) which used to be the center of the Egyptian government for many centuries. Upon arrival, you will visit the [Alabaster mosque](#) of Mohamed Ali, considered a unique reflection of the Ottoman architecture in Egypt and you will enjoy the Islamic Cairo trips with its several mosques and Towers piercing the sky and magnificent colorful domes, which are hundreds of years old and some of them are even older than one thousand years.

Our Coptic Cairo tour will take you to see the Roman fortress of Babylon and the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary well known as Al Mualaka or the suspended church because it was built above the towers of the fortress.

During our Cairo Day Tours, you will also visit the church of the Holy Family or the Church of St Sergius which was built above the crypt inside which the holy family stayed for three months and the spring from which they got their water supplies, then we will go to Ben Ezra Synagogue which is according to tradition built on the spot where the basket of baby Moses was found.

We will stop to have a delicious lunch then we will continue our Islamic Cairo trips to [Khan El Khalili](#) bazaar in the heart of Islamic Cairo, and explore the walls and gates of medieval Cairo and the old streets dating back to the 10th century.

Our representative will take you back to your hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 4: Alexandria Trip from Cairo

After breakfast, get set to meet your proficient English-speaking Egyptologist guide to start the [day tour to Alexandria from Cairo](#) during our Cairo and Alexandria wheelchair tours. We will transfer you from Cairo to Alexandria by air-conditioned vehicles. The trip takes about 2 and a half hours and you will stop on the way for a break.

Finally, you will reach Alexandria, the shining pearl of the Mediterranean and the second capital of Egypt, The name of the city dates back to its founder, the Macedonian leader Alexander the Great, who ruled Egypt in 332 B.C.

Start your sightseeing at the famous site known as Pompey's Pillar, constructed in 297 B.C to celebrate the victory of a Roman emperor named Diocletian (who ruled Rome between 284 and 305 B.C and also took control over Egypt) following a revolt in Alexandria, then you will be transferred to the Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa, which were discovered as soon as the 20th century began and is considered one of the largest burial Roman places, after that, you will drive by the seaside to reach the Citadel of Qaitbay, built on the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse Pharos of Alexandria. It enjoys an excellent position, at the end of a narrow strip of land extending into the Eastern Port.

Visit the oldest center of scientific research in history, The Bibliotheca of Alexandria. which once was the largest in the world. Located in the city that gives it its name, facing the Mediterranean, it was founded at the beginning of the 3rd century BC. C. by Ptolomy I.

You will enjoy eating a seafood lunch made out of the freshest ingredients.

Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo.
