Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Cairo Top Tours representative will meet and assist you at Cairo International Airport, then transfer you by private air-conditioned vehicle to the hotel in Cairo then your 6 Days Cairo and Nile Cruise Wheelchair Accessible Itinerary will be reviewed in case you would like to add any extra trips in Egypt. Overnight in Cairo

Day 02: The Great Pyramid, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo

Start the tour to the Giza pyramids:

The great pyramid of Cheops, the son of Snefru who established the magnificent pyramids of Dahshur, and the second pyramid of Chephren who built it respectively tinier than his Cheops pyramid who was his father, as well as the smallest royal pyramid in Giza that was built for the burial of king Mycerinus, one of the lastest kings of the

fourth dynasty who ruled Egypt before his son King Shepseskaf. Then your specialist Egyptologist will take you to see the Sphinx and outline for you all the historical details regarding this huge statue, and

lastly, you will proceed to the Valley Temple or what we call the mummification temple of king Chephren who is one of the kings and

rulers of the 4th Dynasty and the successor of his father Khufu, the temple was built from Aswan granite quarries and paved with white alabaster.

Then your tour guide and personal driver will take you to enjoy the Egyptian Museum tour and be impressed by the treasures of Tutankhamun.

Stop to eat your delightful lunch and you will relish the Coptic Cairo tour to see the old churches and synagogues beginning with the Hanging Church built above the ruins of an ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Cavern Church of Abu Serga where the holy family took shelter for few months during the holy family journey to Egypt, as well as Ben Ezra Synagogue, the oldest Jewish temple in Egypt. Back to the hotel and overnight after enjoying a gourmet lunch.

Day 03: Cairo to Aswan By Air

Resume your <u>Wheelchair Accessible tours in Egypt</u> after having your breakfast in your hotel. Check out and Cairo Top Tours' representative will transfer you to Cairo International Airport which takes about a 1-hour drive from Giza.

Catch your flight to Aswan which is a 1-hour flight. When you reach Aswan you will be met and transferred to embark on your 5 stars Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor, which is one of the best recommended Egypt Nile River Cruises.

Your accredited tour guide and driver will pick up you in the afternoon to enjoy sailing on the River Nile by Felucca around Kitchener's Island and Agha Khan Mausoleum. Afternoon Tea.

Enjoy your open-buffet dinner which will be served aboard the boat and you will enjoy watching the Nubian Folkloric show.

You have the chance to attend the sound and light show at Philae Temple to learn more about the myth of Osiris and Isis in such a wonderful atmosphere.

Day 04: Aswan Tours, Kom Ombo Temple, Sail to Edfu

After enjoying your breakfast aboard your Aswan to Luxor Nile Cruise, Your Aswan Day tours will take you on a tour to see one of the most outstanding modern projects that are completely associated to raise the Egyptian income, it's the famous Aswan High Dam, the Unfinished Obelisk, which was built by Queen Hatshepsut and described as one of the most important monuments. Visit the Temple of Philae, where you can see the main temple dedicated to the worship of Goddess Isis, mother of Horus. See the two granite lions guard the entrance of the temple; they are of the late Roman era and reflect Byzantine influence.

Transfer back to the Nile cruise boat that will start sailing towards Kom Ombo, an open-buffet lunch during the sailing will be served aboard your luxurious boat. Upon arrival, you will meet your private tour guide to enjoy your astonishing tour to the Temple of Kom Ombo, the double temple erected during the Ptolemaic dynasty and dedicated to God Sobek the crocodile evil spirit according to ancient Egyptian religion, and God Horus. Then the Nile Cruise boat will be sailing to Edfu. enjoy your afternoon tea while sailing, Captain's welcome cocktail.

Dinner will be served aboard the cruise and disco music in the lounge bar for tonight's entertainment. Overnight on board at Edfu.

Day 05: Edfu Temple, Sail to Luxor

Breakfast is to be served aboard your boat, then you will be met by your tour guide to go on the sightseeing tour to the Temple of Horus in Edfu, which contains some of the finest architecture of the Ptolemaic period dedicated to Horus. A large granite statue of Horus stands in front of the entrance guarding the temple. On its head is the Double Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt. after you learn all the information about Edfu you will be back on the Nile Cruise ship and you will start sailing to Luxor. Your lunch will be served on board and the afternoon tea.

In the evening your high-quality dinner is included onboard the ship, then you will enjoy a wonderful traditional Galabya party.

Day 06: Luxor Excursions, Back to Cairo for Final Departure

Today is a big day, in the early morning of your final day during the Tours in Egypt, Take your breakfast aboard the Nile cruise vessel and start disembarkation from your Nile Cruise vessel, now it's time for the interesting Luxor day tours. We will visit the Valley of the Kings, where the pharaohs of the new kingdom from the 18th, 19th, and 20th dynasties chose their eternal tombs. then the Colossi of Memnon and the Temple of El Deir El Bahari which was built to serve as a mortuary temple for Queen Hatshepsut. After the west bank of Luxor tour now we will head to visit the complex of Karnak temple and the charming Luxor Temples during the East Bank of Luxor tour.
