Itinerary

Day 1- Arrival

The tour guide from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will meet and assist you at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u>. After that, you'll meet your tour guide who speaks English before heading to your hotel to check in and spend the night.

Day 2 - cairo day tour to pyramids

Following breakfast, you will be picked up by our tour guide and driven in a luxurious, air-conditioned vehicle to the <u>Saqqara</u> Necropolis' Noble Tombs, where you may visit Irukaptah and King Sekhemkhet's tombs.

Continue on to <u>Memphis</u> Necropolis (Mn Nefer), the first capital of Egypt's Old Kingdom, to see the Mit Rahina open-air museum, where you can view the famed Alabaster Sphinx that was carved from a single large stone block, along with the enormous sculptures of Ramses II.

The Red Pyramid is renowned for being the first accurately shaped pyramid in human history, while the Bent Pyramid is the best intact of the pyramids. You will be escorted by your Egyptologist and private driver to an extra area of the Giza Necropolis known as <u>Dahshur</u>, one of the most interesting ancient Egyptian archaeological sites.

During your <u>Cairo Day Tours</u>, which also include a great lunch at a top-notch neighborhood restaurant, your tour guide will help you take difficult professional photos for the best Egypt Tours memories.

Day3- old cairo tour

Our guide will pick you up when you arrive at the hotel for your all-day trip to Old Cairo. A nice location to begin is the Saladin Stronghold of Cairo, an old Islamic citadel in Cairo, Egypt. Near Cairo's centre, on Mokattam hill, was formerly famed for its refreshing breeze and stunning cityscapes. Before going to Al-Rifa'i Mosque, which is near to Cairo Castle, take a stop for lunch. It is believed that the building, which was built in Sultan Hassan in 1361 and is located across from the Mosque-Madrassa, is a complement to the previous one.

Large mosque and madrassa known as <u>the Sultan Hassan Mosque-Madrassa</u> were built in Cairo's Old City during the Mamluk Islamic era of Egypt. The mosque's astounding size and cutting-edge architectural characteristics were acclaimed as astonishing when it was first constructed. Al-Maqrizi wrote that the mosque was home to various "wonders of construction" and that an-Nasir Hasan, a sultan with a brief and unremarkable history, had ordered its construction.

During Egypt's Mamluk Islamic era, a sizable mosque and madrassa known as the Sultan Hassan Mosque-Madrassa were constructed in the Old City of Cairo. The mosque was unique when it was initially built because of its enormous size and cutting-edge architectural features. Al-Maqrizi said that the unimpressive and transitory sultan an-Nasir Hasan had given the mosque his approval and that it included several "wonders of architecture."

Day 4 -Baharyia oasis tour

Take advantage of our safari tour to the White Desert by 4*4 and the <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> to begin your spectacular White Desert Egypt excursion from your lodging. Travel time from Cairo to the Bahariya Oasis, including a brief break, is roughly four hours.

We will take you to see the Valley of Golden Mummies and the Temple of Alexander the Great, who defeated Persia and governed Egypt in 332 B.C., at the Bahriya Oasis, which is around 420 kilometres from Cairo. The Tombs of the Nobles who governed the area during the 26th dynasty, as well as the Temple of Ein Muftella, which is recognised as one of the most significant buildings in Egyptian history

We'll travel to the hotel for an afternoon at leisure so you can have a dip in the neighbouring hot spring after lunch at a renowned restaurant where you can sample the local cuisine produced with organic ingredients.

We will pick you up once again in the late afternoon and take you up the Black Mountain in the land rover so you can explore the ruins of "the English House" and take in the expansive views of the oasis as dusk sets. The nocturnal hours of Bahariya.

Day 5- the withe desert tour

We'll travel to the <u>White Desert</u>, which is a part of Farafra Oasis, after breakfast. On the route, we'll stop for a rest stop to see the Black Desert, which is made up of a number of Black formations and mountains that are densely covered with ancient volcanic rocks. The next place we'll pass through is the Valley of El Haize, the final village of Bahariya to the south. If you'd like, you can take a hot spring bath right here.

In order to practise sandboarding and witness the quartz crystal in the Crystal Mountains, we'll subsequently drive you to the magnificent Valley of Agabat. Last but not least, you'll spend the night camping in the White Desert and get to see a magnificent sunset as your guides prepare your delectable lunch.

Day 6- back cairo

After a hearty breakfast, you'll head to the White Desert to explore the hot springs and marvel at the magnificent white limestone formations that you have been shaped over thousands of years by the yearly sandstorms that pass through this region. These formations are known locally by many names, including the Mushroom and the Rabbit.

When you get to Bahariya Oasis, you'll change to a more comfortable vehicle and take Bahariya back to your Cairo hotel.
