We'll take you to the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, also known as the Alexandria Library, which was one of the largest and most significant libraries of the ancient world.

Next, you'll visit The Citadel of Qaitbay, a fortress constructed in the 15th century by Mamluk sultan Al-Ashraf Sayf al-Din Qaitbay on the site of the Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Afterward, you'll be able to explore the grand land of pharaohs in <u>Cairo</u>; the Giza Pyramids, which are recognized as one of the seven wonders of the world due to their enormous size. Later, we'll head to <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>, also referred to as the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, located in Cairo, and founded in 1835, which is one of the most important museums globally showcasing ancient Egyptian artifacts.

Day 01: arrival in Alexandria

Alexandria International Airport is your destination where you will find our representative holding a signboard with your name to transfer you to your hotel, where your Egyptologist guide will accompany you through your 4 Days Wheelchair Accessible trip from Alexandria to Cairo and will review the itinerary of your Egypt Wheelchair accessible Tours to confirm that everything is going according to the plan.

Day 02: a visit to Pompey's Pillar, the Citadel of Qaitbay, and The Alexandria Library

Today after enjoying your breakfast, your tour guide will transfer you to <u>Pompey's Pillar</u> the tallest memorial monument in the world our first destination on this day.

there you Explore the ruins; The area around Pompey's Pillar is home to a variety of ancient ruins, including a sphinx and several other structures. Visitors can wander through the ruins and imagine what life was like in ancient Alexandria.

also, you can take photos; Pompey's Pillar and the surrounding ruins offer plenty of opportunities for photography. Visitors can take panoramic shots of the surrounding area, or snap close-up shots of the intricate carvings on the column.

after that, we will take you to <u>The Citadel of Qaitbey</u> is considered one of the most important defensive fortresses, there you can learn about the citadel's past through the various exhibits in the museum, which include artifacts and weapons from the fortress's history. also, you can climb to the top of the citadel and take in the breathtaking views.

then continue our trip to one of the largest and most important libraries on the Planet, <u>Bibliotheca</u> <u>Alexandrina</u>, there you will able to Explore the library, Visit the planetarium which offers a range of shows and exhibitions about astronomy and space science

at the end of our day, we will take you to have lunch at a Seafood restaurant

Day 03: a visit to Giza Pyramids, the Egyptian Museum

After breakfast, check out from the hotel, and you will be transported to Cairo with our licensed tour guide and personal driver. The travel time between Cairo and Alexandria, which is 216 square kilometers, might take up to 2.5 hours, depending on the state of the roads.

we will take you to Giza Pyramids to see the three pyramids. where you can see <u>the Great Pyramid of</u> <u>Cheops</u> which was constructed from over 3 million blocks of stone and considered an engineering wonder, the Pyramid of <u>Chephren</u> which is somewhat smaller in dimension but not less in prominence, and the Pyramid of Mycerinus who was the hire of the throne of Egypt during the same <u>4th dynasty</u>

after that, you will visit <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>, where you can Explore the museum's exhibits, View the King Tutankhamun collection which includes his sarcophagus and various other artifacts from his tomb. You can view these impressive treasures and learn about the life and legacy of this famous pharaoh.

After taking your tasty delicious lunch in a very good-class restaurant, we will take you back to Alexandria
