After resting for a while, comes the next part of our trip; visiting Coptic and Islamic Cairo. Where we will find, the hanging church, Salah El Din Citadel, Al-Azhar mosque, and finally Khan el-Khalili market, to end our wonderful trip and return you back to your hotel.
