Itinerary

Day 1: Tour to Giza pyramids, Egyptian Museum and Old Cairo

The trip starts in Giza, where you can visit <u>the great sphinx</u>, which is shaped like a lion with a pharaoh's head on top, as well as the more than 4,500-year-old <u>Giza pyramids</u>. Our Egyptologist will also go into the historical building methods used to build these structures.

Our next trip will be to <u>the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir</u>, which is one of Egypt's most significant museums because it has the most extensive artifacts connected to ancient Egyptian history. This exhibit showcases some extraordinary treasures that belonged to Pharaohs and their ancestors, including the spectacular tombs of King Tutankhamun and the intriguing room of mummified animals. Additionally, it has more than 100,000 artifacts from many cultures that have had a variety of influences on Ancient Egyptian Civilization over the course of thousands of years.

We'll then eat lunch in a genuine Egyptian restaurant in Cairo. From this point on, we will include a stop in the Islamic district of <u>old Cairo</u> in our itinerary. The first stop on the excursion will be at <u>the</u> <u>Saladin Citadel</u>. You can go to the "Mohamed Ali Mosque" in this spectacular citadel to see the fortifications. It is significant to remark that the entire ancient city can be seen from this castle.

At the end of this historical journey, you will see Coptic Cairo, the city's Christian district. The Holy Family concealed during their flight to Egypt in the Ben Ezra Synagogue, <u>the Hanging Church</u>, and the Church of St. Sergius, also known as the Church of the Cave.

After such a program in the lovely cities of Cairo and Giza, we finally transport you back to your hotel.

Day 2: Baharia Oasis and White desert tour

The day trip starts from your hotel in Cairo at 7:00 AM and travels through the surrounding desert regions. Our first stop of the day will be the stunning <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>, a desert that is recognised throughout the world for its enticing beauty and spectacular landscapes.

We would change from the minibus to the jeep when we arrived, then we would begin travelling to the Western Desert. Get ready for an unforgettable desert adventure loaded with thrilling thrills. Tour the oasis with the aid of your guide, taking in the vast surroundings of shady palm trees and natural springs.

After lunch, continue your day trip through <u>the white desert of Egypt</u> with a visit in the neighbouring Agabat, a stunning valley with imposing white cliff walls and yellow limestone cliffs. You can practise sandboarding on the sand dunes here with a Jeep 4x4. A few sand dunes can be climbed for endless views.

After travelling deep into the desert, we would eventually arrive at the volcanic mountains, which resemble volcanic cones and rise from the desert. We would journey to the black basalt-covered volcanic summit known as Al- Marsous. To acquire a comprehensive perspective of the Oasis's surroundings, let's pause at the viewpoint.

You will go to <u>Egypt's Crystal Mountain</u> as your final stop. This desert site is breathtakingly magnificent and covered in a layer of black basalt. The surroundings have a particular aura of mystique because to the sun-glittering crystals. Although there are minerals nearby, you shouldn't

take any with you.

Around 10 PM, our tour guide and driver will take you to your hotel in Cairo

Day 3: Day trip to Alexandria

Our tour guide will be waiting for you in the hotel lobby at around 6:30 a.m. for a lovely day excursion to Alexandria. We will travel to Alexandria, Egypt's most important Mediterranean city, from Cairo.

Your first stop will be the 15th-century stronghold known as <u>the Citadel of Qaitbey</u>, which is situated in the port. The ruins of the iconic Alexandria lighthouse, which it once housed, are still discernible. Then visit <u>the catacombs at Kom el Shogafa</u>, the largest Roman cemetery with three levels carved out of rock and a notable first-century archaeological site. On its three underground floors are more than 300 mummies, the most common burial deities, and several Greco-Roman themes.

Lunch will be served in a seafood restaurant where you can try some of the most well-known Egyptian delicacies. You'll visit Alexandria's Pompey Column and the Serapeus Temple Ruins once you've had a chance to rest and recover at <u>the Pompay Pillar</u>. Some historians claim that this important Roman general was killed in battle and buried here.

At the end of the day, you'll go to <u>the Bibliotheca Alexandrina</u>, one of the most important cultural centers in the eastern Mediterranean. In the late afternoon, we'll return you to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 4: Final departure

On the final day, our tour guide will be there to pick you up in the hotel lobby at the appointed hour so you can be driven back to <u>the Cairo airport</u> and leave Egypt with new experiences, breathtaking images, and irreplaceable memories.
