## Day 1: Arrive Cairo / Check-in / Overnight

# Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour / Old Cairo Tour

After breakfast, your English-speaking tour guide will meet you at the hotel to begin your <u>tour of the Giza Pyramids</u>. The pyramids of Giza include the Great Pyramid of <u>King Cheops</u> and the Middle Pyramid of his son <u>Chephren</u>, two of the oldest wonders of the world that are still standing today. You will also see <u>the Great Sphinx</u> and <u>the Valley Temple</u> of King Chephren.

You will be transferred to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, which houses the most extensive collection of Egyptian antiquities in the world. Also on display is the golden treasure found untouched in the Valley of the Kings and a group owned by <u>King Tutankhamun</u>.

You will then visit the <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u> where you will see the <u>Roman fortress of Babylon</u> and <u>The Hanging Church</u> raised above two towers of this Roman fortification. Next, you will visit <u>the church of Abu Serga</u> and the Synagogue of Ben Ezra.

Enjoy a traditional Egyptian lunch at one of Cairo's most famous restaurants. After lunch, we'll visit Cairo's famous mosques—including the Fatimid Khan el-Khalili and the Mosque of Ibn Tulun—to get a feel for Islamic Cairo. We'll finish our tour with a stroll through the Khan El Khalili bazaar, one of Cairo's oldest markets for some souvenir shopping, before returning to our hotel.

#### Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

Prepare to leave your hotel in Cairo to be transported to Cairo International Airport for a domestic flight to Luxor, where you will be met by a representative of our company.
