<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Welcome to Cairo:

On your first day, we will make arrangements for your transportation to and from <u>Cairo airport</u>. transfer to your hotel, check-in will be explained to you, and we'll review your schedule and pick-up times with you.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saggara / Memphis

After breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your private tour guide and depart. You may visit the Valley Temple of Khafra, take a camel ride during the <u>Giza Pyramids tour</u>, and see the wonders that the Egyptian pharaohs created in this wonderful collection there (Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus). These are two of the most incredible locations on the planet.

Following lunch, travel to <u>Memphis</u>, another breathtaking destination that once served as the Old Kingdom capital of ancient Egypt.

Before visiting the <u>Step Pyramid</u> of King Djoser in Saqqara, which is a great monument and contains some magnificent tombs of the nobles, like the one facing the Pyramid of King Teti of the 6th dynasty, the tomb of Kagemni to see some impressive scenes of ancient Egyptian art, you can find the enormous statue of Ramses II here along with other intriguing artifacts. After your tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, you will return to the hotel for the night.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, copitic and islamic Cairo:

Hotel breakfast is available. You will be met and driven to enjoy the <u>Egyptian Museum tour</u> in a private vehicle by one of our English-speaking Egyptologists. The <u>Egyptian Museum</u> is a historical site with several stunning monuments and artifacts.

It's fun to have lunch at a nearby restaurant. the Saladin Citadel, which is located in Salah El Din, and the Mohamed Ali Mosque, which was constructed in 1805 AD in the Turkish style of design and is shockingly similar to the Blue Mosque of Turkey. The following attractions on your trip are the Ben Ezra Synagogue, the Blessed Virgin Mary Church, also known as the Hanging Church, and the St. Sergius Cave Church. You'll be driven back to your accommodation at the conclusion of your day's adventures in Cairo.

Day 4: Luxor East bank Sightseeing Tour:

Your Cairo day adventures will start, After breakfast, meet with our guide at the hotel. He or she will help you load your private vehicle and drive to Cairo airport, where your flight to Luxor will be waiting for you. When you get there, Luxor will transport you to your hotel so you can relax. Afterward, proceed to the city's east bank to see the magnificent Karnak Temple and Luxor Temple. the next day, arrange for transportation to your lodging. to your hotel again

Day 5: Luxor West bank Sightseeing Tour:

Our tour guide will meet you and help you after breakfast at your accommodation. Before moving on to the Colossi of Memnon and Queen Hatshepsut Temple at El Deir El Bahari as part of your sightseeing tour of Luxor, you may view The Valley of the Kings in the West Bank (gigantic statues for Amenhotep III.) We'll eat lunch at a nearby restaurant before the trip. After that, you'll be transported to your hotel in Luxor to spend the night.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (The High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk)

During breakfast, the next morning, one of our agents will pick you up from the hotel and take you to Aswan. When you arrive in Aswan, a fresh agent will be present to transport you to your accommodation. See the High Dam, which has had a big impact on Egypt's economy and culture, after you check in and relax. After finishing your adventure with a visit to the famed Unfinished Obelisk, which tells us the story of carving the obelisk, you will be driven to your accommodation in Aswan for the night.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light Show)

After breakfast, your tour of Aswan continues to the <u>Philae Temple</u>, one of the four locations where the story of Isis, Osiris, and Horus occurred. This was the temple that the goddess Isis used to visit. Lunch at a neighborhood restaurant.

Then. You'll head back to your hotel room in Aswan. The <u>Philae Temple sound and Light Show</u> are among Aswan's most beautiful evening events. We'll go deeper into the mythology surrounding the deity Osiris and the goddess Isis as well as the history of ancient Egypt.

As the Philae Temple site was regularly underwater for six months out of the year, it was in jeopardy. The temple was moved to Agilika Island's higher ground level after a significant and crucial campaign to attempt to prevent it from vanishing due to the tremendous flooding of water that occurred in the middle of the 20th century. While you visit the island's most important monuments and learn about its history, take in the breathtaking laser shows that highlight the majesty and splendor of the

historical environment.

After the performance, you will board a boat to return to the harbor, where a shuttle will transport you to your Aswan lodging.

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

Breakfast is offered at hotels. A member of our staff will offer you a personal, air-conditioned <u>tour of Abu Simbel</u>. You'll visit the Ramses IV Temples in Abu Simbel. When your journey is finished, a driver will take you to Aswan's airport where you may catch a flight back to Cairo. Spend the night in Cairo by checking into your hotel.

Day 9: Final Departure

Enjoy your breakfast before being transferred to Cairo International Airport for your final flight.
