<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1 - Arrival

At <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, you will be greeted by a representative of our company. They will drive you to your hotel in Cairo in an air-conditioned vehicle, assist with check-in, and then depart so you can get ready for the following day.

Day 2 - Cairo - Egyptian Museum & Great Pyramids

After breakfast, our tour guide will pick you up at your lodging and drive you to the Giza Necropolis. The <u>Great Sphinx</u>, the King Khufu Valley Temple, and the Great Three <u>Giza Pyramids</u> are all seen there. You will then have lunch before visiting <u>the Egyptian Museum</u> of Tahrir with your guide.

After the day is done, we'll take you back to your hotel in a car.

Day 3 - Coptic Cairo & Khan El Khalil

Your tour guide will meet you there and transport you to <u>Old Cairo</u> so you may visit the Coptic section of the Egyptian city.

The day tour's first stops will be in Old Cairo at the Ben Ezra Synagogue, the Hanging Church (which is shaped like Noah's ark), and the Church of Abu Serga. All of these spots are thought to have served as Jesus' hiding places.

Before returning to your accommodation, you will get the opportunity to explore the <u>Khan el-Khalili</u> market and sip some traditional tea at the Al Fishawy Café.

Day 4 - Nile Cruise - Aswan

Your transfer to Aswan will take place on the fourth day.

The next morning, check out of your Cairo lodging and drive yourself to the airport to catch your flight to Aswan.

As you board your <u>Egypt Nile Cruises</u>, get ready to visit the High Dam, the Philae Temple, and <u>the Unfinished Obelisk</u> with your tour guide, who can teach you everything there is to know about the history of each location.

Make your way back to your ship for dinner at the conclusion of the day.

Breakfast, lunch, and supper are the meals.

Day 5 - Nile Cruise - Luxor East Bank

Your day journey to Luxor in the East Bank will begin after breakfast when you meet with our tour guide and are taken to the <u>Ramses II</u> granite statues at the <u>Karnak temple</u>. Your next visit after lunch will be to <u>the Luxor Temple</u>.

At the end of the day, take a shuttle back to your cruise ship.

Breakfast, lunch, and supper are the meals.

Day 6 - Luxor West Bank - Cairo

Check out of your Nile Cruise in the morning before being driven by our guide to see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> and the temple of El Deir El Bahri (the Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut).

Before seeing the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, the Temple of Medinet Habu, and Deir El Madina the worker's village where all the artisans and craftsmen who helped adorn the tombs at the Valley of the Kings once lived until their passing have lunch at a local restaurant. This was done to conceal the location of the necropolis from tomb raiders.

You will be driven to the airport at the conclusion of the day to catch your domestic aircraft to Cairo.

Day 7 - Alexandria Tour

To get from Cairo to Alexandria, you will board a private air-conditioned car with our guide.

The Sultan Quitbay Palace, the <u>Pompay Pillar</u> a spectacular memorial built in honor of Emperor Diocletian the greatest Roman cemetery, and <u>the Catacombs of Kom El Shokafa</u> three levels of tunnels carved into the subterranean rock. They demonstrate the compatibility of Roman and Egyptian art.

Visit the <u>Alexandria Biblioteca</u> after that, and then return to your accommodation in Alexandria.

Day 8 - Alexandria - Siwa

When you leave your hotel in Alexandria, your professional guide will take you in a private A/C vehicle to the <u>Siwa Oasis</u>.

Starting in the ancient city of Siwa, your full-day excursion will pass by the Alexander Temple and the <u>Amun Ra Temple</u>. A few other attractions include the Tombs on the <u>Mountain of the Dead</u>, the Siwa Museum, and the Crocodile Tombs.

Pay a visit to Siwa and stay the night.
