Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

At <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will be waiting for you inside your terminal with a signboard bearing your name and the name of the business, <u>Cairo Top Tours</u>. He will drive you in a private, air-conditioned vehicle to your accommodation in Cairo. Register at the hotel. In addition to helping you check in without incident, our representative will go over the itinerary of your Egypt family trip package with you in order to go over and update all pick-up times for your tours in Egypt.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour

Meet our representative early in the morning at the hotel to begin your <u>Giza Pyramids</u> tour. You will tour <u>the Great Sphinx</u> and the Valley Temple facing the mythical figure that is thought to have been constructed for King Khafra as well as the three enormous pyramids in Giza that were built for the three kings of the old kingdom, Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. During your tour of the Giza Pyramids, you'll get the excellent opportunity to ride camels around the monuments to get the best images possible with the assistance of a Bedouin guide.

Then, make your way to the downtown Cairo area, specifically the well-known Tahrir Square, to begin your private tour of the Egyptian Museum. Your tour guide will provide you with a wealth of information about the numerous artifacts inside the Egyptian Museum, which was built in 1902 and contains thousands of statues and coffins.

Afterward, we'll eat lunch at a nearby restaurant.

After your day trips in Cairo are over, take a transfer back to the hotel.

Day 3 : old cairo tours

From your hotel, our tour guide will pick you up to go to the most popular sites in old Cairo.

We'll now head to Old Cairo for an educational <u>Coptic Cairo tour</u>. Here, you'll see the <u>Hanging Church</u> of the Holy Virgin Mary, which dates back to the beginning of Christianity in Egypt. You'll also see the Cavern Church of Saint Sergius and the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, which is Egypt's oldest Jewish place of worship.

After your day trips in Cairo are over, take a transfer back to the hotel.

Day 4: Cairo to Luxor, East Bank of Luxor Tour

Check out of your hotel in Cairo and be transferred by a representative of Cairo Top Tours in a vehicle to the Cairo International Airport. Take the flight to Luxor, where our representative will meet you and take you to the pier for your Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise. Your Nile cruise tours begin in Luxor and end in Aswan.

<u>The Temple of Luxor</u> and <u>the Karnak Temple</u>, two of the largest and most significant temples in ancient Egypt built by numerous monarchs including Amenhotep III, are the places to start your travels in Luxor today.

On board and overnight, take advantage of the lunch and dinner buffets.

Day 5: West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu

Enjoy a full breakfast on board the Nile cruise ship before meeting your guide to begin your west bank of Luxor tours. You'll visit the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, an architectural marvel constructed by Hatshepsut, a well-known and powerful queen during the 18th dynasty, <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, where you can see many rock-cut tombs for various kings of ancient Egypt, as well as the Colossi of Memnon,

Return to your cruise ship and spend the night there.

Day 6: Visit to The temple of Edfu / the temple of Kom Ombo

Your breakfast will be an open buffet and provided on the Nile River Cruise. Then, be ready as your expert Egyptologist guide takes you to see the well-preserved Edfu Ptolemaic-style temple, which is devoted to God Horus, who according to ancient Egyptian religion is the defender of royalty. After being returned to the ship, you can explore the <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which is devoted to the crocodile Gods Sobek and Haroeris. As the Nile cruise ship heads toward Aswan, enjoy your lunch, which is being provided to you.

On board your luxurious Nile cruise, a sumptuous meal will be served as you enjoy the Nubian Show while spending the night at Aswan.

Day 7: Aswan Tours

Before arriving in the lovely city of Aswan to see the renowned Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, enjoy your excellent breakfast on board the boat. This structure was built to lessen the deadly impact of the river Nile's yearly floods. We will travel with you by boat to the magnificent Temple of Philae, a temple to the goddess Isis that is ideally situated on an island. The Unfinished Obelisk, which was most likely built by Queen Hatshepsut, is the largest known Obelisk in the Aswan granite quarries after that.

Once your Aswan sightseeing tours are complete, your tour guide will bring you back to the cruise ship.

Enjoy your meal and the night on the ship.

Day 8: Disembarkation, Back to Cairo

You now have a fantastic opportunity to go by land or air early in the morning to <u>Abu Simbel</u>, the most impressive Egyptian temple constructed by Ramses II. (Selective Activity)

Your representative will transfer you to Aswan Airport so you can catch your flight back to Cairo on the final day of your Egypt Nile River Cruise after you have a delicious breakfast and check out of the cruise ship. When you arrive, your private transportation will take you to your accommodation in Cairo.

Cairo overnight stay

Day9: arrive fayoum

Your tour guide will pick you up from your accommodation in Cairo and drive you more than 90 kilometres to the well-known sights of El Fayoum. Start your day excursion from Cairo to El Fayoum to see one of the largest Greco-Roman ruins, Karanis, which was constructed in the third century BC under Ptolemy II's authority.

Visit the Pyramid of Hawara, one of El Fayoum's most breathtaking monuments, which was constructed by Amenembat III, a pharaoh of the 12th dynasty (1814 BC–1860 BC), whose reign is regarded as the Middle Kingdom's golden age (2055 BC – 1650).

Continue to observe the water wheels at Al Fayoum; as they were used for agriculture, they were essential to the area's economy. Today, the governorate of El Fayoum's official symbol is represented by the water wheels.

Visit <u>Wadi Al Rayan's waterfalls</u> and Lake Qarun, one of the most notable historic natural lakes, where activities like bird watching, fishing, and water sports are popular. Then, make the transfer back to your Cairo lodging.

Day 10: Fly to Sharm El Sheikh

Enjoy a sumptuous breakfast at the hotel, and then the Cairo Top Tours representative will accompany you to the domestic departure terminal at Cairo International Airport to catch your flight to Sharm El-Sheikh. After being greeted and assisted at Sharm Airport and being transferred to your hotel, you will have the chance to escape the crowds and unwind on Sharm El-beautiful Sheikh's beaches.

Day 11: Free Day at Leisure in Sharm El Sheikh

Day14: Alexandria Day Trip from Cairo

To start your day journey from Cairo to Alexandria, the lovely city that was founded in 332 B.C. by the famous Macedonian commander and ruler Alexander the Great and served as Egypt's capital for approximately 1000 years, you will meet up with your certified Egyptologist guide.

Before moving on to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, an ancient catacomb with three floors below ground and ornamented from the inside with a mixture of Pharaonic and Greco-Roman styles of art and architecture, you will first see Pompey's Pillar, which is situated within the ruined Serapeum of Alexandria.

Transfer to the Citadel of Qaitbay, constructed with the remains of the former Lighthouse Pharos. On our approach to a restaurant with a view of the water where we will eat a lovely seafood lunch, we will pass by the contemporary Bibliotheca of Alexandria.

For the overnight stay, we will return to Cairo in the same car.

Day 15: Final Departure
