Day 01 :arrival in Cairo

Upon arriving at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, you will be greeted by an English-speaking representative who will assist you with any procedures and transport you to Cairo Pyramids Hotel for the night to rest.

Day 03: The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and Suez Canal

After breakfast, our professional tour guide will meet you at your Cairo hotel and take you on a breathtaking tour to (NMEC),

The museum showcases a vast collection of artifacts, including sculptures, paintings, pottery, and jewelry, dating back to prehistoric times up to the present day. It connects the Mediterranean Sea to the Red Sea and allows ships to travel between Europe and Asia without having to go around the southern tip of Africa. there you will see the impressive engineering that makes this waterway so important. you can get there a panoramic view of enormous Boats through the Suez Canal then you will have Sea Food Lunch after that, you will be transferred back to Cairo.
