Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Cairo:

We will arrange transportation for you to and from <u>the Cairo airport</u> on your first day. We will walk you through each stage of check-in and reassess your schedule and pick-up timings with you.

Prepare for tomorrow now.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

You will meet your private tour guide and depart after breakfast at the hotel. You may see the <u>Valley</u> <u>Temple</u> of Khafra, ride camels inside <u>the Pyramids of Giza</u>, and take in all the wonder that the Egyptian pharaohs constructed in this magnificent collection there (Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus). These are two of the most amazing places on earth.

After lunch, proceed to <u>Memphis</u>, another stunning location that was formerly home to ancient Egypt's Old Kingdom.

You can find the enormous statue of Ramses II here along with other intriguing artifacts before visiting the <u>Step Pyramid</u> of King Djoser in Saqqara, which is a great monument and contains some magnificent tombs of the nobles like the one facing the Pyramid of King Teti of the 6th dynasty, the tomb of Kagemni to see some impressive scenes of ancient Egyptian art. You will return to the hotel for the evening following your tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum ,copitic and islamic Cairo :

Breakfast is offered in hotels. Our English-speaking Egyptologist guide will meet you and take you in a private vehicle to <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>. Several beautiful monuments and historical items can be found at the Egyptian Museum, a historical location.

Lunch at a local eatery is enjoyable. the Mohamed Ali Mosque, which was built in 1805 AD in the Turkish style of design and is startlingly similar to the Blue Mosque of Turkey, and <u>the Saladin Citadel</u>, which is situated in Salah El Din. For more information on Islamic Cairo Tours, go here. The Ben Ezra Synagogue, the Blessed Virgin Mary Church, often called the <u>Hanging Church</u>, and the St. Sergius Cave Church are the next sights on your tour.

Your day trips in Cairo will end with a drive back to your hotel.

Day 4: Luxor East bank Sightseeing Tour :

Meet with our guide after breakfast at your hotel, and he or she will assist you in getting into your private vehicle and driving to the Cairo airport, where your flight to Luxor will be waiting for you. As soon as you arrive, Luxor will drive you to your hotel so you can unwind. See the majestic Karnak Temple and Luxor Temple by going to the city's east bank next. Get transported to your accommodation the next day.

Day 5: Luxor West bank Sightseeing Tour:

After breakfast at your lodging, our tour guide will greet you and assist. You can see <u>The Valley of the Kings</u> in the West Bank as part of your sightseeing tour of Luxor before continuing to <u>The Colossi of Memnon</u> and Queen Hatshepsut Temple in El Deir El Bahari (gigantic statues for Amenhotep III.) Before the journey, lunch will be had at a neighboring eatery. You'll afterward be driven to your hotel in Luxor where you'll spend the night.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (The High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk)

The next morning after breakfast, one of our representatives will pick you up from the hotel and drive you to Aswan. A new agent will be waiting to bring you to your hotel in Aswan when you get there. After checking in and unwinding, go to <u>the High Dam</u>, which has significantly influenced Egypt's economy and culture. You will be taken to your hotel in Aswan for the night after ending up your journey with a visit to the fabled <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which recounts us the tale of carving the obelisk.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light Show)

<u>The Philae Temple</u>, one of the four sites where the tale of Isis, Osiris, and Horus took place, is the next stop on your tour of Aswan after breakfast. The goddess Isis had a temple here that she used to worship.

Lunch at a nearby restaurant.

Then. You'll return to your Aswan hotel room. One of the most stunning nighttime activities in Aswan is the <u>Philae Temple Sound and Light Show</u>. We'll delve in-depth into the history of ancient Egypt and the mythology surrounding the goddess Isis and the god Osiris.

The Philae Temple's site was in danger because it was frequently submerged for six months out of the year. After a major and vital campaign to try to save it from disappearing because of the heavy flooding of water that happened in the middle of the 20th century, the temple was transported to the higher ground level <u>Agilika Island</u>, where it is presently. Take in the stunning laser shows that showcase the majesty and magnificence of the historic setting as you tour the island's most significant structures and discover its history.

You will board a boat to return to the harbor after the show, where a shuttle will take you to your accommodation in Aswan.

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

Hotel breakfast is available. You'll be given a private, air-conditioned tour of <u>Abu Simbel</u> by a member of our team. You'll go to Abu Simbel's Ramses IV Temples. You will be driven to the airport in Aswan after your trip is over so you can board your aircraft back to Cairo. Check into your hotel in Cairo and spend the night there.

Day 9: Final Departure

Enjoy your breakfast before being transferred to Cairo International Airport for your final flight.
