Itinerary

Day 1 (Egypt): Arrival

Our professional team will meet you when you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to assist you with all arrival procedures and take you in an air-conditioned private car for check-in to your accommodation in Cairo.

Spend the rest of your night at your Cairo hotel.

Day 2 (Egypt): Giza Pyramids, Memphis and Saqqara

Your breakfast will be served in the morning before our certified tour guide meets you to start your tour of the Great Pyramids and Saqqara.

The tour will start off with the pyramid of King Cheops, the greatest of all the pyramids that exist on the planet Earth, it was built by the hands of 100,000 workers as expected by archeologists and historians.

The huge pyramid of King Chephren was built almost 20 years after the Great Pyramids using millions of lime-stone blocks by the son and the heir of Cheops who belongs to the 4th dynasty Pharaohs, and the small pyramid of Mycerinus. And you will learn how the pyramids were constructed by ancient Egyptians.

Then, go down to see the Great Sphinx or Shepsep-Ankh which means the living image of the deity.

Stop after your Giza Necropolis tour to take a traditional Egyptian lunch in a local restaurant, then proceed to Saqqara plateau, where you are going to see the famous Step Pyramid, the <u>Tombs of Nobles</u> during the Old Kingdom, and enjoy the fantastic color of the daily life scenes inside. Finally, you will get the chance to enter the Pyramid of King Teti or the Pyramid of King Unas.

Your last destination on this day is Memphis City; the capital of Egypt during the pyramid's building age for almost one thousand years, and it is considered a very important cultural and also religious capital of the Egyptian empire throughout the three thousand years of ancient Egyptian history. You will visit the Museum of Memphis to see the treasures of the ancient city including the alabaster sphinx and the huge statue of King Ramses II.

We will transfer you back to your hotel at the end of the day.

Day 3 (Egypt): The Egyptian Museum and Old Cairo

Your tour guide and personal driver will meet you in the morning after having your breakfast to visit one of the most important museums in the world; the Egyptian Museum, you will get to the exhibition of ancient Egyptian treasures including the famous gold mask of King <u>Tutankhamen</u> after having your delicious breakfast at the hotel in Cairo.

Then we will take you to the Citadel of Saladin which was built during the twelfth dynasty to reinforce Cairo and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali Basha, one of many buildings inside the citadel and belongs to the Albanian origin ruler of Egypt during the 1st half of the 17th century. Enjoy the scenery of Islamic Cairo with all the amazing mosques, captivating minarets, and interesting domes.

Lunch will be served in a nearby restaurant and you will continue our Coptic Cairo tour to visit the old Roman fortress, so-called the fortress of Babylon and the Hanging Church, and also the church of Abu Serga or the church of the Holy Family. Our last stop in Coptic Cairo includes visiting the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, one of the oldest synagogues in Egypt and the Middle East.

At the end of our Cairo Day Tours, we will move to Islamic Cairo to experience an old medieval bazaar when you visit Khan El Khalili,

After the end, Your driver will take you back to Le Meridian Pyramids resort to spend another night in Cairo.

Breakfast and Lunch included

Day 4 (Egypt): Cairo to Sharm

Have your breakfast at your hotel and get prepared to be transferred to Cairo International Airport to take your flight from Cairo to Sharm El Sheikh.

After that, head to the city of Jerash to have a tour of the area and return to your hotel for the rest of the night.

After breakfast, explore Dana; an area of staggering beauty, history, and biodiversity. Move then to Kerak to visit the ruins of its medieval castle which is also known as Kerak Fortress; one of the largest castles in the Levant.

Camp in Wadi Rum.

Day 10 (Jordan): Wadi Rum

After taking your breakfast at the camp, tour the protectorate of Wadi Rum where you will get to see old rock glyphs, canyons, and cliffs.

Transfer at the end of the day to Aqaba to check in to your hotel.

Day 11 (Jordan): Petra

On this day of your trip, you will take a tour of the city of <u>Petra</u>, the lost city, which is famous for its rose-red rocks and is one of the New Seven Wonders of the World.
