Classic Dubai City Tour

This classic <u>Dubai City Tour</u> will take you into the old city of Dubai and introduce you to the historical part of the city. Your guide will pick you up in the morning from your hotel and drive you to the heritage sites of Al Bastakiya, the old part of Dubai is an area characterized by its narrow streets and charming courtyards. Afterward, you will enter the Dubai Museum, located in the Al Fahidi Fort. You will then board the Abra, a traditional water cab typical of the region, for a ride along the estuary while admiring another perspective of the city. The day continues to cross the Dubai Creek to the Spice Souk, where the most typical smells, colors, and flavors blend together. On the way back, you will have time for shopping at the most famous place in Dubai: the Gold Souk.

Continue your half-day city tour of Dubai and make a photo stop next to the Jumeirah Mosque, one of the many jewels of the UAE. Next, you will take a photo stop at the Burj Al Arab, the iconic face of Dubai that has set high standards of service like no other. At the ending of the tour, you will be returned to your selected hotel.
