Morocco Sahara Desert Tour

A tour of the Sahara Desert in Morocco means a fantastic journey through beautiful landscapes, ancient cities, and nomadic cultures. It is usual for tourists to start from lively Marrakech, exploring its bustling souks and the historic medina. With dramatic Atlas mountains in between, there are traditional Berber villages as well as valleys that will leave you breathless along the way.

With more exploration to the south, Sahara the land changed to large golden desert sand dunes. Thus, you can experience the magic of desert sunrise and sunset after riding camels in these dunes for some time, rather than spending a night at a traditional nomad camp.

<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Marrakech - Ouarzazate - Erfoud - Merzouga (550 Km, 8 hours' drive)

We will pick you up in Marrakech at the place you like best in the morning and then set off to Erfoud via Ouarzazate and Tizen Tichka (2260 m), the highest pass in the Atlas Mountains. Ouarzazate was constructed in 1928 and is nowadays a starting point for tours in South Morocco. Nevertheless, it has grown into more than just a stopover town where travelers can make an overnight stay. However, there is a choice for a meal in Ouarzazate before we continue our trip to Erfoud.

Once you arrive in Erfoud, you will go by 4X4 car to the deep desert of Merzouga. Dinner and overnight under a nomadic tent in the desert.

Day 2: Merzouga - Erfoud -Todra Gorges - Dadès

Wake up early and use camel-back to enjoy the dawn. You will then have breakfast at your dessert camp before driving back to Erfoud in a 4x4 car on time. In Erfoud, find a driver who could take you towards dadès through Tinghir and the popular Todra Gorges where Todra Gorges in Morocco is 300 meters high and one of the most renowned sites."

The Todra Gorge is located in Morocco and spans 300 meters. It is considered one of Morocco's most stunning sites. In Morocco, Todra Gorge has become a prime spot for climbing and trekking, with its towering cliff walls that provide sport multiple-pitch climbing routes numbering in hundreds. You should spend some moments here delighting in the magnificence of this place, before heading further southwest to the town of Bomalene Dades where you will find beautiful kasbahs built on surrounding hillsides overlooking the valley below and mountains above.

Dinner and overnight at your hotel

Day 3: Dadès - Ait Benhaddou - Marrakech

Have breakfast in your hotel and then drive back to Marrakech through the fascinating Ksar of Aït Benhaddou. This is true of the great Kasbah Ait Benhaddou. It has also been listed by Unesco as a global heritage humanity site with its buildings really in ochre adobe color. It was a film set for several well-known movies, such as Laurence of Arabia or Gladiator. If you want, you can have lunch before proceeding to Marrakech. Drop off at your preferred location in Marrakech.
