Day 1: Arrival in Muscat

Our friendly representative from Cairo Top Tours will be there to welcome you and offer assistance as soon as you arrive at Muscat Airport. You will then be transferred to your Muscat hotel, guaranteeing a trouble-free and seamless beginning to your journey.

Day 2: Muscat City Trip

After raising your breakfast at your hotel, the next part of your day will be devoted to a hallucinatory half-day city tour to Muscat. In conducting this tour, you will have a chance to visit the main highlighted places and tourist sites. Among the interesting points is the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, considered one of the most notable architectural nuggets globally.

Another prominent attraction is the Bait Al Zubair Museum, which boasts an exciting ensemble of antiquities, authentic Omani arms, ornaments, outfits, and various domestic utensils. The museum also recreates town and country situations during the Omani tradition. Moving towards Old Muscat, you will be immersed in the beauty of golden mountains, and as your vehicle passes by historic Jalali and Mirani forts from the 16th century, your every step will be a fusion of glorious past and modernisation.

The itinerary of the tour will include a visit to Al Alam Palace, the place where His Majesty Sultan Qaboos, the ruler, stays. A visit to Oman's Muttrah, the primary port zone, is a chance to take a guided tour of a lively, crowd-filled antique market, full of aromas, colours, and traditional local items. To finish the tour, you will return to the hotel at night to enjoy the rest of the day in Muscat.

Day 3: Wadi Shab and Ras Al Jinz Tour

Departing from Muscat, you will travel to Quriyat, a charming coastal fishing village, and then continue to Tiwi and Fins. Here, you'll find a stunning white sandy beach that invites you to relax and enjoy a refreshing swim. The journey then takes you along a graded track to Wadi Shab, one of Oman's most breathtaking wadis. This wadi is characterized by its flowing fresh water and is surrounded by lush banana plantations and rocky trails.

Continuing along the coastal road, you'll reach the towns of Sur and Ras Al Hadd, where arrangements have been made for an overnight stay. After dinner, you'll have the opportunity to visit Ras Al Jinz, a protected reserve known for its green turtle nesting. During the nesting season, you may be fortunate enough to witness the awe-inspiring sight of turtles laying their eggs at night. You'll spend the night in Ras Al Hadd, enjoying the unique natural beauty of the area.

Day 4: Wadi Bani Khalid and Wahiba Sands Trip

Following breakfast, you will embark on a drive to Wadi Bani Khalid, a captivating wadi known for its lush greenery and cascading water that forms a picturesque turquoise pool, perfect for a refreshing swim.

Day 5: Nizwa and Jabrin Tours

Additionally, Nizwa's bustling Souq is well-known for its Friday cattle auction, as well as its intricately hand-carved "Khanjars" (daggers) and exquisite silver jewellery.

Following the exploration of Nizwa, the next stop is Jabrin Castle, considered the finest castle in Oman. This architectural gem was constructed in the late 17th century and is renowned for its stunning ceiling paintings and intricately crafted woodcarvings, showcasing the highest achievements of Omani craftsmanship.

The day concludes with a journey back to Muscat, where you will spend the night, allowing you to rest and recharge for the next day's adventures.
