Day 1: Arrival to Istanbul

After you arrive at Istanbul Airport, our tour leader will welcome you with a signed board. He will pick you up and transport you to your hotel.

Overnight in Istanbul.

Day 2: Sightseeing Tour in Istanbul

After breakfast, you can explore the crowded streets of the Grand Bazaar, the world's oldest and biggest covered market area - where you can bargain for spices, fabrics, and mementos up to your satisfaction. Give your shopping an hour off and explore the amazing Turkish street food at the sites of the cafés, shacks, and stalls, which offer the finger-licking experience of tasting top-quality succulent kebabs, crispy borek, or sweet Turkish delight.

In the afternoon, instead of being surrounded by them all, cross over the Galata Bridge and find peace and tranquility in the fashionable district of Karakoy. Get around the Jewish quarter to look at the charming little boutique shops and art galleries and sit down at one of the hip cafes. You will visit the historic Galata Tower and climb it for stunning views of the city and the sparkling waters of the Bosphorus.

Day 3: Flight to Cappadocia / Cappadocia Tour

We will pick you up from the hotel at 4:00 a.m. after breakfast and transfer you to the airport for a flight to Cappadocia. When you arrive at Istanbul Airport, please proceed to the counter to complete self-check-in and obtain your boarding ticket by producing your passport. Please go to the boarding gate and embark using the information on your boarding card.

After arriving at the Airport, the driver will pick you up at the exit of the first gate. (Holding a sign with your name.) Transfer to join the Northern Cappadocia Tour. You will visit the Goreme Panorama, which offers a spectacular view over Goreme Village, the land of fairy chimneys. You will also see the Open Air Museum, which is the region's largest monastery complex.

In the afternoon, walk down the Red River, Turkey's longest river, and visit a little hamlet noted for its ceramic industry. You will be able to witness how pottery is formed and you can try to do that by yourself if you want. End of the day, return to the hotel by passing via Love Valley, which offers a beautiful view. Arrival at the hotel, free time, and overnight stay at Cappadocia's cave hotel or a similar hotel.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch.

Day 4: Pamukkale Tour

Arrival at Pamukkale early in the morning, picked up by the agent at the bus terminal and sent to the hotel for a few hours to clean up before breakfast. The agent will then pick you up between 10:30 and 11:00 a.m. and take you to Pamukkale-Hierapolis Tour. Pamukkale includes hot springs and travertines, terraces of carbonate minerals formed by flowing and cooling water.

Turks refer to it as 'Cotton Castle- Pamukkale' because it appears to be made of cotton. Visit Hierapolis Ancient City, a Unesco World Heritage Site, which used to be frequented by people to relieve their ailments during retirement and even to die there. You may refresh yourself by walking on the terraces or swimming in

the Cleopatra Swimming Pool. (Optional)

At the end of the excursion, go to Cardak Airport and fly to Istanbul. Arrival at the airport, picked up by an agent, and transferred to the hotel.

Overnight in Istanbul.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch.

Day 5: Final Departure

The hotel offers a breakfast buffet before giving guests free time to rest. Following that, you will be taken to the International Airport for your last departure.
