<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival Istanbul

Your English-speaking driver will greet and help you at Istanbul Airport, then accompany you to your hotel to begin your Turkey Tour. Check into your accommodation and spend the day exploring Istanbul.

Overnight in Istanbul.

Day 2: Istanbul City Tour

After breakfast, you'll enjoy a full day exploring the city. Visit the Hagia Sophia, which was erected by Emperor Constantine in the fourth century and turned into a mosque by the Ottomans in the fifteenth century. The next stop will be Topkapi Palace, which served as the Ottoman Sultan's palace from the 15th to the 19th centuries and has an amazing treasury, elegant harem, charming courtyards, and pavilions containing vast antiquities collections.

Then you'll go to the Blue Mosque, one of the world's most prominent religious structures, known for its six minarets and magnificent interior painted with beautiful blue Iznik tiles.

Lunch at a nearby eatery. The next visit will be the Hippodrome, which hosts chariot racing. Our final trip will be the Grand Bazaar and free time. Transfer to the hotel.

Overnight in Istanbul.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 3: Bosphorus Day Tour

After breakfast, visit the Spice Bazaar, one of Istanbul's most colorful and crowded attractions. Next, take a spectacular cruise around the Bosphorus, Istanbul's breathtaking waterway that connects Europe and Asia. This journey includes visits to landmarks including the Palaces of Dolmabahce, Ciragan, and Castle of Rumeli Hisari, among others.

You continue our tour by visiting the Beylerbeyi Palace, which was erected in white marble by Sultan Abdulaziz in the nineteenth century and functioned as a summer retreat for successive sultans as well as a guesthouse for foreign guests. Lunch at a nearby eatery. Climbing Çamlica Hill, often known as the Hill of Lovers, provides a breathtaking perspective of the Bosphorus and Istanbul. Finally, return to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 4: Flight to Cappadocia / Cappadocia Tour

After an early check-out, you will be picked up from your Istanbul hotel to board your flight to Kayseri Airport. Visit the famed "Devrent Valley" and "Pasabagi" (Monk's Valley). After lunch at a local restaurant in Avanos, a town on the banks of the Kizilirmak Red River, you'll view some of Turkey's most famous handicrafts.

In the evening, you will visit Göreme's Open Air Museum and the Uchisar Rock Castle. The journey will conclude with a visit to the Underground City of Kaymakli, one of the region's best-preserved and deepest subterranean villages. Valle de Tres Bellas offers a stunning perspective of Urgup, a city known for its wine, as well as vineyards with apricot orchards where you can always capture great images. Finally, you will be taken to your accommodation after visiting Goreme Panorama, a panoramic stop south of Goreme.

Overnight in Cappadocia.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 5: Cappadocia Day Tour / Flight to Istanbul

Following breakfast, a full-day tour to Cappadocia. First, we'll walk 4 kilometers via Valle de Rojo y Rosado. During this magnificent tour, you will see the fauna and flora of Cappadocia, which is rich in minerals and filled with vineyards. After lunch at a local restaurant near the Valle de las Palomas, the tour will proceed to the incredible underground city. It comes from one of the region's best preserved and deep underground settlements, dug as early as the second millennium BCE.

Before lunch, we will approach the Valley of Love, formerly known as Valle Blanco, which provides a stunning panorama with its gracefully formed chimneys. Then we'll go to the old Christian village of Cavusin, which has been heavily eroded and partially fallen, but still has wonderful vistas. Following this visit, we will go to the Village of Uchisar, where a natural stone castle provides excellent photographic opportunities from all sides, as does one of the region's monuments.

After the trip, you will be taken to Kayseri Airport for your return journey to Istanbul. When you arrive at Istanbul Airport, you will be transferred to your hotel in Istanbul for an overnight stay.

Day 6: Final departure

The hotel serves a breakfast buffet before providing free time for relaxation. After that, you will be transferred to the International Airport for your final departure.
