Then, you'll be off to Cappadocia, the region where the geographical features resemble another world and riddles are plentiful in the form of cave dwellings. Among the sites you will visit are the Library of Celsus, the temple of Artemis, and the Grand Theatre where gladiators and athletes displayed their rows for admiration. Cotton Castle is the name given to Pamukkale because of its natural beauty and unique structure. This is one destination that you simply do not want to pass up. On the same day, you will visit another ancient city called Hierapolis, which was built out of hot springs; and you will go for a swim in the Cleopatra Pool too.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival Istanbul

Your English-speaking driver will help you at Istanbul Airport, and then accompany you to your hotel to begin your trip to Turkey. Check into your accommodation and spend the day exploring Istanbul.

Stay at Istanbul.

Day 2: Istanbul Day Tour

After breakfast, we'll begin our full day in the city at the Hagia Sophia. This church was originally erected by Emperor Constantine in the fourth century; the Ottomans transformed it into a mosque in the fifteenth century.

Next, explore the Topkapi Palace, which is the Ottoman Sultan's palace from the 15th to the 19th centuries, with its spectacular treasury, elegant harem, lovely courtyards, and pavilions containing vast antiquities collections.

Then see the Blue Mosque, which is one of the world's most prominent religious monuments, notable for its six minarets and magnificent interior painted with the iconic blue Iznik tiles. You will have a delicious lunch at a nearby eatery.

The next destination is the Hippodrome, which hosts chariot racing. The last stop is at the Grand Bazaar. You will be transferred to the hotel.

Day 3: Bosphorus Tour

After breakfast, you will visit the Spice Bazaar, which is one of Istanbul's most vibrant and crowded attractions. Next, we go on an incredible cruise around the Bosphorus, which is Istanbul's beautiful waterway that connects Europe and Asia. This journey includes visits to landmarks including the Palaces of Dolmabahce, C?iragan, and Castle of Rumeli Hisar?, among others.

You will continue your tour by visiting the Beylerbeyi Palace, which was erected in white marble by Sultan Abdulaziz in the nineteenth century and functioned as a summer retreat for successive sultans as well as a guesthouse for foreign guests. You will have your lunch at a nearby eatery. Climbing C?amlica Hill, which is also known as the Hill of Lovers, provides a breathtaking perspective of the Bosphorus and Istanbul.

Day 4: Fly to Cappadocia - Cappadocia North Tour

Before an early check-out take your breakfast, then you will be picked up from your Istanbul hotel to board your flight to Kayseri Airport. Continuing your Istanbul and Cappadocia trip, you'll see the famed "Devrent Valley" and "Pasabagi" (or Monk's Valley). After lunch at a local restaurant in Avanos, a town on the banks of the Kizilirmak Red River, you'll view some of Turkey's most famous handicrafts.

In the afternoon, you will visit Göreme's Open Air Museum and the Uchisar Rock Castle. Three Beauties Fairy Chimneys offers a stunning perspective of Urgup, a city known for its wine, and vineyards with apricot orchards where you can always snap unique images. Finally, you will be taken to your accommodation after visiting Goreme Panorama, a panoramic stop south of Goreme.

Finally, you will be taken to your hotel to check in.

Overnight in Cappadocia.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch.

Day 5: Cappadocia South Tour

After breakfast, a full-day tour to Cappadocia. First, we'll trek 4 kilometers through The Red Valley. During this magnificent tour, you will see the fauna and flora of Cappadocia, which is rich in minerals and filled with vineyards. After lunch at a local eatery near The Pigeon Valley, the tour will proceed to the incredible underground city. The city has eight floors and is made of soft volcanic stone.

Before lunch, we will approach the Valley of Love, formerly known as the White Valley, which has a stunning panorama with its gracefully curved chimneys. Then we'll go to the old Christian village of Cavusin, which has been heavily eroded and partially fallen, but still has wonderful vistas.

Following this visit, we will go to the Village of Uchisar, where a natural stone castle provides excellent photographic opportunities from all sides, as does one of the region's monuments. Finally, visit a carpet studio to see how the world's famous Turkish rugs are produced, as well as an onyx and jewelry workshop.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch.

Day 6: Cappadocia / Flight to Izmir / Kusadasi

After breakfast, you will be taken to Kayseri Airport for your return trip to Izmir. Upon arrival, meet our driver and be taken to your hotel in Kusadasi.

Overnight in Kusadasi.

Day 7: Pamukkale / Hierapolis / Kusadasi

After breakfast, we will pick you up from your hotel for a full-day trip to Pamukkale and Hierapolis. The Cotton Cliffs, one of the world's natural wonders, are located in Pamukkale and were produced by calcareous salt deposits.

Visit the historic ruins of Hierapolis, with its basilica, theater, and Roman Baths. After the trip, you will be taken to your hotel approximately 19:00.

Overnight in Kusadasi.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch.

Day 8: Kusadasi / Day tour in Ephesus / Istanbul

Breakfast. Then, in the morning, we'll drive to Ephesus to see its beautiful library, theater, and temples. Then we head to Virgin Mary's House and the Basilica of St. John.

In the afternoon, attend an energetic fashion display exhibiting Turkey's distinctive leather items. Then transfer to Izmir Airport for our domestic trip to Istanbul.

Overnight in Istanbul.
