Itinerary

Day1: Hey there from Rwanda

When you arrive at Kigali International Airport, our representative will meet you outside the customs and immigration hall. He will then introduce you to your driver guide, who will take you to your hotel in Kigali (15-minute drive). When you arrive at the hotel, you will check in and then enjoy dinner.

Day2: Transfer to Musanze Visit Ibyi Iwacu / Ex-Poacher's Village.

After breakfast at 8:00 a.m., begin your Rwanda safari with a city tour of Kigali followed by a scenic transfer to Musanze with photo stops (2 hours 30 minutes). Upon arrival, you will check into your lodge and then eat lunch. Then go to Ibyi Iwacu Cultural Village.

Day3: Exploring Gorillas

presently your day begins with a 6:00 a.m. drive to the Volcanoes National Park workplaces for the 7:00 a.m. Gorilla Trekking meeting. You will begin your walk at 8:00 a.m. Volcanoes National Park safeguards the rugged sides of this beautiful mountain range and is home to the rare mountain gorilla, as well as an extensive variety of montane ecosystems such as evergreen and bamboo forest, open grassland, swamp, and heath. However, the main attraction will be spending an hour with the amazing peaceful gorillas, who, in spite of their size and appearance, go about their daily lives of feeding, playing, resting, and raising their young. Stay overnight at the Da Vinci Gorilla Hotel.

Day 4: Say Goodbyes from Kigali

The following day, you are free to enjoy leisure activities before departing for Kigali. The route takes you through scenic plantations and lush green hills before arriving in Kigali to depart.
