Itinerary

DAY 1: Arrive in Beirut

Your journey begins with your arrival at Beirut International Airport. Our agent will greet you and transfer you to your hotel.

Overnight in Beirut.

DAY 2: Jeita Grotto and Harissa cable car tour

After breakfast, you will leaving Beirut and traveling north to Byblos, we will pay a visit to the breathtaking Jeita Grotto. A limestone cave system spanning over 9 km features one of the world's biggest collections of stalactites and stalagmites. It represents the country and was a finalist in the New 7 Wonders of Nature competition. Depending on the water level, you can explore either on foot or by boat.

Afterwards, we travel to Harissa, which is famed for having an important Christian shrine devoted to the Virgin Mary known as Our Lady of Lebanon. We take the cable car to the top of the Basilica, where we can enjoy a breathtaking view over the Bay of Jounieh, regarded as one of the most beautiful bays in the Middle East.

DAY 3: Baatara Gorge tour - Fly to Egypt

After your final breakfast in Beirut, we'll travel inland to the remarkable Baatara Gorge sinkhole, where a 255-meter waterfall pours into an immense cavern known as the Baatara Pothole in the spring and especially during wet seasons. The cave is also known as the Cave of the Three Bridges, because to the three natural stone arches that span the waterfall. This is a stunning natural occurrence, and we have time to go for a short climb and see adjacent Douma Village.

Then we will take you to Beirut Airport for your journey to Cairo. When you arrive at the airport, our personnel will greet you, help you in acquiring your visa and bags, and then take you to your hotel to begin your journey. They will assist you in settling in, introducing you to the surrounding region, and explaining tomorrow's plans.

DAY 4: Pyramids, Sphinx & Museum tour

After breakfast, our Egypt tour begins with a journey to Giza on the outskirts of Cairo, where we will see the <u>Sphinx</u> and Egypt's three great pyramids. One of our native Egyptologist experts will accompany you on this and all of your other sightseeing trips, and you'll find them to be knowledgeable and enthusiastic about Egyptian history and their nation in general.

After visiting the Pyramids of Giza, we proceed to the Egyptian Museum. The museum, which houses

the spectacular <u>Tutankhamun</u> display, also has a vast collection of other ancient Egyptian artifacts.

DAY 5: Old Cairo & Khan El-Khalili tour

Take your Egyptian breakfast, and let's explore the back streets and bazaars of <u>Old Cairo</u> is a fascinating experience that offers a glimpse into the city's rich history and vibrant culture. As you walk through the Bab al-Futuh gateway, you'll be stepping into a world filled with the sights, sounds, and smells of traditional Egyptian markets.

As you continue your walk, you'll gradually make your way to the <u>Khan-El-Khalili</u> bazaar, one of the oldest and most famous markets in Cairo. Here, you'll find a bustling atmosphere filled with locals and tourists alike, browsing the shops and haggling for souvenirs.

After exploring the bazaar, you'll have the opportunity to take a break and enjoy some mint tea and a shisha pipe, a traditional Egyptian water pipe. This is a great way to relax and soak in the sights and sounds of the market before continuing your exploration.
