Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo departure

Start your luxury tour with an enjoyable Egypt group tour package at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, Our representatives from Cairo Top Tours will assist you and guide you.

You will then be transferred to your hotel in Cairo, where you will meet your tour manager to review your Egypt tours and confirm your check-in time.

Day 2: Exploring Ancient Cairo

Begin your adventure by exploring the iconic landmarks of Ancient Cairo. Visit the world-famous Giza Plateau, where the magnificent Great <u>Pyramids of Giza</u> and the enigmatic <u>Sphinx</u> stand proudly. Marvel at the architectural wonders and hear captivating stories about their construction and historical significance.

Afterward, delve into the rich history of Cairo as you explore the treasures of the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> to discover the fascinating artifacts, including the treasures of Tutankhamun, and gain a deeper understanding of Egypt's ancient civilization.

Day 3: Tours of the Luxor East Bank

You will be taken to the Cairo airport for your trip to Luxor in the early morning after breakfast and hotel check-out. As always, our agents will greet and help you upon arrival, making sure the transfer to your five-star Egypt Nile cruise on the Steinberger MS Minerva goes well. After a delectable lunch, start your tour of the Luxor East Bank on board.

The largest man-made religious site in the world, the spectacular <u>Karnak Temple</u>, will be your first trip. Admire the magnificence of the ancient Egyptian buildings and the elaborate hieroglyphic writings as you explore this enormous complex. Discover its historical significance as the ancient center of governmental and religious power.

After that, pay a visit to the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, which will be exquisitely lit at night. Experience a step back in time as you take in the splendor of this temple and try to picture the wealth and extravagance of ancient Egypt. Admire the temple's enormous statues, strong columns, and intricate carvings. You will be taken back to the cruise ship for dinner and a leisurely evening aboard as you continue your voyage along the Nile after finishing the tour of the Luxor East Bank.

Meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor - Edfu

Breakfast can be enjoyed at a delicious buffet on board the Nile cruise ship, beginning in the early morning. Your Egyptologist guide will then take you on a tour of the West Bank of Luxor, where you will be privileged to see the many treasures of the ancient civilization.

Proceed to <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>; this is one of the most incredible cemeteries of the New Kingdom, where more than 62 Pharaohs were stationed, starting from Tutankhamun and ending with Ramses II.

Next, go to the Temple of Hatshepsut, or <u>El Deir El Bahari</u>, with remarkable architectural illustration of the age. It is a temple dedicated to the long lineage of kings of Egypt, particularly the rule of the first female pharaoh of Egypt, Hatshepsut. I always wanted to see the temple from 'The Mummy' movie [specifically the Queen Temple].

Following a delicious lunch on one of the cruises, cruise to Edfu, where dinner and a show are available on board the cruise.

Optional: I will be participating in a hot-air balloon tour in Luxor.

Day 5: Coordinates of the Temple of Edfu, Kom Ombo

where the archaeological digging was conducted are as follows:

Continental Plus, another oriental breakfast in the main restaurant of the Nile Cruise at the beginning of the day. Subsequently, stop at the preserved 'Temple of Edfu' built during the Greco-Roman Ptolemaic Period. This splendid temple also aims at the falcon-headed deity of Horus and thus gives the visitors important and informative information concerning the philosophies and practices of the kingdom of the Pharaohs.

After that, cruise to Kom Ombo and explore the <u>temple of Kom Ombo</u>, also known as the Temple of the Edfu.

Have your lunch on board the ship as it sets off for the <u>Aswan day tour</u> and enjoy the scenery of Uganda, especially on the Nile.

Meals: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 6: Tours to See Aswan's Sights

After enjoying breakfast on the Nile cruise, your guide will take you to the remarkable <u>High Dam</u>, the most significant project in modern Egypt and an engineering marvel; next, you will drive to the Unfinished Obelisk, the largest known obelisk found in the Aswan granite quarries; and finally, you will visit the magnificent <u>temple of Philae</u>, which is dedicated to the goddess Isis and is beautifully situated on an island. Once again, enjoy your meal and overnight stay on the boat.
