Then, travel to AlUla, a Sufi city famous for its ancient archaeological sites, including the UNESCO-listed Hajar (Madain Saleh). Continue your journey to Madinah, the second-holiest city in Islam. Visit the Prophet's Mosque and immerse yourself in the spiritual atmosphere of this sacred city.

Finally, conclude your tour into Jeddah, the gateway to Mecca and a melting pot of cultures. Discover the city's bustling markets, known as souks, and admire the blend of modern skyscrapers and traditional architecture.

<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrive Riyadh

Welcome to Riyadh! Arriving in Riyadh marks the beginning of your adventure in the capital city of Saudi Arabia. Check into your hotel.

Rest and relax after your journey

Optional: Explore the local area or dine at a nearby restaurant

Day 2: Riyadh Day Tour

Begin your day with a visit to the UNESCO-listed Diriyyah, a historic site on the outskirts of Riyadh. This site is revered as the birthplace of the first Saudi state and currently serves as the residence of the royal family.

Stroll through the old town to marvel at its well-preserved ruins, including the magnificent palace, residences, and marketplace. Next, visit the Masmak Fort in Riyadh's old quarter, erected during the reign of Abdullah bin Rashid in 1895 A.D. Then, immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere of Dirah Souq.

In the afternoon, Head to the National Museum, a national treasure and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its eight galleries offer a comprehensive narrative of Arabian history, spanning from the genesis of the universe to the contemporary era.

Conclude your day at the Murabba Palace, constructed by King Abdul Aziz in 1937. Return to your hotel for a restful overnight stay.

Overnight: Riyadh. **Meals**: Breakfast, Lunch.

Locations mentioned: Diriyyah, Masmak Fort, Dirah Souq, the National Museum, and Murabba

Palace.

Day 3: Flight from Riyadh to Al Ula

Have your breakfast in the morning, Transfer to the airport for a flight to Al-Ula. You will explore Madain Saleh, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the southernmost settlement of the Nabatean kingdom. Known as 'Al Hegra' in ancient times, it was a prosperous stopover on a trade route. The site covers 2000 square meters with relics and rock-cut tombs.

After that, Visit the Nabatean Well, Qasr Al Bint, Diwan Tomb, Al Farid Palace, and the preserved railway station. Then proceed to Harrat Uairedh for panoramic views of the landscape. Enjoy the sunset with Arabic coffee or tea and dates.

Return to the hotel in Al Ula for an overnight stay.

Overnight: Al Ula.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner.

Locations mentioned: Nabatean Well, Qasr Al Bint, Diwan Tomb, Al Farid Palace, Harrat Uairedh.

Day 4: Al Ula Tour

Start your full-day tour in Al Ula by meeting your guide in the hotel lobby. Explore the wonders of Dadan and Jabal Ikmah, both World Heritage-listed sites. Jabal Ikmah is known as a vast open-air library with the highest concentration and most diverse inscriptions in Al Ula.

Dadan, the capital of the Dadan and Lihyan kingdoms, is a stone-built city with a rich history dating back to the 9th and 8th centuries BCE. The city features over ten tombs carved into red-rock cliffs, including the famous 'Lion Tombs', which are lion sculptures marking the burial sites of elite society members.

After exploring the mountains, visit the Old Town to learn about Al-Ula's history and take a leisurely stroll through the oasis and local farms. Meet a local family and enjoy tea with them. Afterward, visit the iconic 'Elephant Rock'. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Al Ula.

Overnight: Al Ula.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner.

Locations mentioned: Dadan, Jabal Ikmah, The Lion Tombs, Elephant Rock

Day 5: Flight to Jeddah

Transfer from your hotel or resort in Al Ula to catch your flight to Jeddah. Arrive at Jeddah airport in the evening and transfer to your hotel for check-in and overnight stay.

Overnight: Jeddah. Meals: Breakfast.

Day 6: Day Tour to Madinah by High-Speed Train

In the morning, you'll be picked up from your hotel and taken to Jeddah train station to board the high-speed seating train to Madinah. The trip takes around 2 hours, with a maximum 300 km/h speed.

Upon arrival at Madinah train station, your private guide will meet you and take you on a day tour. You'll visit the International Fair and Museum of the Prophet's Biography and Islamic Civilization, as well as Qiba Street, which connects the Holy Mosque and Qiba Mosque, including Souq Taiba.

Enjoy lunch at one of the 5-star hotels overlooking Prophet Mohamed Mosque. Please note that access to the mosques is not allowed for non-Muslims, but you can still see them from the outside.

After the tour, board the train for the return trip to Jeddah. Upon arrival at Jeddah train station, you'll be transferred privately to your hotel for an overnight stay in Jeddah.

Overnight: Jeddah.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Visits: International Fair, Museum of the Prophet's Biography and Islamic Civilization, the Holy

Mosque, Qiba Mosque, Prophet Mohamed Mosque.

Day 7: Jeddah

This morning, your day starts with a visit to the Tayebat Museum. This privately owned museum spans four floors and features a diverse range of exhibits, including pre-Islamic artifacts, exquisite Islamic manuscripts, old coins, weaponry, furniture, pottery, and traditional Saudi dress.

After the museum visit, continue your Saudi trip with Memphis Tours by visiting the Jeddah Open Museum. This museum boasts one of the largest collections of models and is situated in a picturesque area on the new corniche, offering plenty of picnic options. You'll also see the 'floating mosque,' which appears to drift on the water's surface, shimmering in the sunlight. Take a moment to appreciate the spectacular views over the Red Sea.

Next, explore King Fahd's Fountain, also known as Jeddah Fountain. It is the tallest of its type in the world, shooting salt water from the Red Sea 300 meters up into the air at speeds over 300 kilometers per hour.

Later, you'll be led to Jeddah's traditional architecture in Al-Balad (Old Town). Here, you'll visit some of the old Ottoman houses constructed from coral and reinforced with wooden beams. One of the highlights is Nasif House, built in the 1850s by the influential Nasif Family, known for their significant trading history in Jeddah.

Return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Jeddah.

Overnight: Jeddah Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Location mentioned: Tayebat Museum, Jeddah Open Museum, Floating Mosque, King Fahd's

Fountain.

Day 8: Depart Jeddah

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
