## Day 1: Arrival in Riyadh

The person in charge of your tour will be there to meet you. They will be holding a sign with the name Cairoptours on it. You don't have to search for them, they will come to you and find you. You will be taken to your hotel in a cool car with air conditioning. You will stay in Riyadh for the night.

## Day 2: Riyadh Historical Tour

Breakfast. Let's start our tour at the National Museum of Saudi Arabia in Riyadh. This museum is very important because it shows the history of Saudi Arabia, including how the kingdom was formed and information about the royal family. Inside, you will see old items like antiques, manuscripts, and documents that are arranged in order of when they happened. There are eight main halls in the museum, each focusing on a different part of Saudi history. You'll see things like ancient skeletons, a huge rock from the desert, and old artwork. It's a great place to learn about the history and culture of Saudi Arabia. Next, have fun exploring the beautiful gardens at the National museum park. It is one of the most amazing gardens in Saudi Arabia that you will love visiting with your family. After that, go to the Hall of King Abdulaziz where you can see a display of old cars that the king used. Next, we will go to visit Murraba palace, which is a very special palace built by King Abdulaziz. He built this palace for his family to live in. The palace was made in the traditional style of the area, using materials that were found nearby. You can see some really cool pictures of the inside of the palace here. First, you will go to a special market in Saudi Arabia called Dira Souq. It has a lot of old things made out of copper and brass, like silver daggers, jewelry, and clothes. When you walk in, you can smell a nice sandalwood scent. Dira Souq is a good place to buy old carpets and other cool things from Saudi Arabia's history. Then, you will visit a place called Al Masmak. It's like going back in time to learn about Saudi Arabia's past. There are interesting things to see, like maps and pictures of Saudi Arabia, as well as old objects and artwork. They even have a movie that shows how King Abdul Aziz captured the fortress, and you can still see his spearhead in the wooden gate. We can go on a fun adventure to explore the red sand dunes in Riyadh. We will start early in the morning at 5:00 am and the tour will last about 4 hours. Transportation to and from the dunes is included. Let's go on a fun tour to try different foods in Riyadh starting at 4:00 pm!

### **Day 3: Al Ahsa Oasis**

In the morning, we will have breakfast and then begin our journey to a place called Al Ahsaa. It is about 300 kilometers away from Riyadh. When we arrive there, we will visit a special building called Jawatha Mosque. It is also sometimes spelled as Al-Jawan. This mosque is found in a village called Al-Kilabiyah, which is about 12 kilometers away from Hofuf in Al-Ahsa, Saudi Arabia. This mosque was one of the first ever built in eastern Arabia, but now most of it is broken down and not standing anymore. Next, we will go to a place called Al-Ahsa in a city called Hofuf. There is a big mountain there called Mount Qara, which was formed around 2.5 million years ago. It is 210 meters tall and about 1,000 meters long from north to south and 800 meters wide from east to west. This mountain is made of rocks. It is a famous landmark in the area and was visited by King Abdullah bin Abdul Aziz Al Nahyan when he came to Al-Ahsa in 1313 AH. We will be staying in Riyadh for one night.

### **Day 4 : Riyadh City Tour**

Breakfast. Begin your tour by visiting Diriyah, which is an important historical site. It was the capital of the first Saudi state and has a lot of history. Diriyah is where Saudi Arabia was first established. Some parts of Diriyah, like the mud houses, are being renovated so you can only see them from the outside for now. Ad Diriyah was a city in the desert near Riyadh that had walls made of mud bricks. It was a busy and important place for trade and culture. Al Turaif district is a very old and important place where the rulers of Saudi Arabia used to live. It was the first capital city of the country and played a big role in creating Saudi Arabia as we know it today. The ruins of Al Turaif are now being carefully fixed up to show its history and importance to everyone. In Ad Diriyah's Al Bujairy district, there is a famous religious scholar named Mohammed bin Abdul Wahab. The area has narrow streets that lead to old mud houses that have been turned into beautiful heritage sites. After that, you will go to Kingdom Tower or Mamlaka Tower, which is the

tallest building in the city. It is located in the Oalya district in Riyadh. This tower is very well-known in Riyadh. Inside the tower, there is a shopping mall with many stores and places to eat. You can also visit the Sky bridge Al Mamlaka for an extra fee, where you can see a beautiful view of the city. There are also restaurants and shops in the tower. You will get to visit The Al Rajhi Grand Mosque, which is the biggest mosque in Riyadh. It is really cool and important in the city. The mosque has two libraries, teaches about forensic science, has a high-tech system, and can fit a lot of people inside. At the end, we will go to a very special library called The King Fahd National Library. It is a place where important books and information are kept for the whole country of Saudi Arabia. The library is very beautiful and has a really cool design. It is in the middle of the city and a lot of people like to visit it. The library was made in 1983 because the people of Riyadh wanted a special place to keep all their important books when a new king came into power. ## Day 5 : Day Trip to Jeddah

Next, you will go see Al Shafi Mosque, which is the very first mosque ever built in Jeddah.

This special tour will show you all the cool places in Old Town that not many people know about. We will visit important places like Beit Nassif and the Makkah gate for pictures. You will also get to see old houses that mix traditional and modern styles. We will explore hidden treasures in the Old Market, secret art galleries, and special food shops that only locals know about, not tourists.

Next, you will go to Al Tayebat International City Museum. It's like a big puzzle with lots of rooms that show things like Saudi history, pretty decorations, and artwork from Saudi Arabia and other Islamic countries. You can also take lots of cool pictures there.

The museum has four floors with lots of different things to see. They have old things from before Islam, beautiful books, coins and weapons, and really cool furniture and clothes from Saudi Arabia. They even have models of different homes from all over the country. Each thing on display has a sign with good information, and there are also little models of different places in Saudi Arabia.

Finish the tour by taking a fun ride along The New Jeddah Corniche, which is a 30 km coastal area in the city of Jeddah. It has a road by the sea, places to play and relax, and big sculptures for everyone to see and take pictures with.
