Day 1: Arrival to Riyadh

Day 2: Riyadh Historical Tour

For breakfast, start your day by visiting a really cool museum in Saudi Arabia. This museum is a special place where you can learn all about the history of Saudi Arabia, the royal family, and how the country was formed. Inside, there are lots of old things like ancient artifacts, old writings, and important documents. These things are all organized in order, so you can see how things happened over time.
