<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Tours of Aswan and Embarkation

Your first day begins with a certified tour guide who will meet you at your hotel in Aswan, or <u>Aswan Airport</u> or railway station. You will then be transferred to commence your 4-day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor. Upon boarding your 5-star Nile River Cruise, an open-buffet lunch will be served.

After lunch, your Aswan excursions will start with a visit to the <u>High Dam</u>, an engineering marvel considered one of the most significant projects in modern Egyptian history. The High Dam has protected Egypt from the annual Nile floods and provided a crucial power source for the country.

The Unfinished Obelisk:

Your Aswan day tour continues with a visit to the granite quarries to see the Unfinished Obelisk, believed to have been commissioned by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> during the New Kingdom. This obelisk, located in a red granite quarry, provides insight into ancient Egyptian stonemasonry.

Philae Temple:

Next, you will take a motorboat to the remarkable <u>Philae Temple</u> on Agilika Island. Known as Philae in Greek and Pilak in ancient Egyptian, meaning "the end," this temple is associated with the myth of Isis and Osiris.

After completing the Aswan tours, you will be transferred back to the Nile cruise boat where dinner will be served. You will spend the night aboard the boat in Aswan.

Meals: Lunch and dinner

Day 2: Cruise to Edfu / Kom-Ombo Temple

After enjoying a delightful breakfast aboard the cruise vessel, passengers have the opportunity to join a tour of <u>Abu Simbel</u>. Following lunch, the Nile cruise will proceed towards Kom Ombo. Upon arrival, passengers will explore the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, which holds historical significance for its role in the training of African elephants for military use. This temple is dedicated to the crocodile <u>god Sobek</u> and Haroeris, an aspect of the god Horus.

Day 3: Visit to Edfu Temple for Exploration

Begin your day with a pleasurable breakfast aboard the MS Nile Radamis Nile River Cruise. After breakfast, embark on a steed-drawn carriage lift through the city of Edfu to visit the Temple of Horus. Following the stint, lunch will be served on the vessel. Enjoy autumn tea as the voyage continues its trip towards Luxor, where you'll be accommodated for the night. In the evening, guests have the option to share in a fresh excursion to the Sound and light show at Karnak Temple.

Day 4: Saying goodbye to Luxor

The stint begins with a visit to the magnific <u>Karnak Temple</u>, constructed by colorful dictators between 2200 and 360B.C. You'll also visit the <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, established between 1400 and 1000B.C. by dictators <u>Amenhotep III</u> and <u>Ramses II</u>, as part of the Luxor East Bank tenures.

Next, the Luxor <u>West Bank</u> tenures will take you to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where you can explore multitudinous royal sepultures. In ancient times, this vale was known as "Ta Iset Maat," meaning" place of verity." You'll also visit the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>, known as the Northern Monastery, designed by the mastermind Senenmut and devoted to Hatshepsut, the only woman to reign over Egypt for an extended period. also, you'll see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>. After completing these classic tenures of Egypt, you'll be transferred to your preferred destination in Luxor. In the early morning, there's a voluntary excursion available a <u>Hot Air Balloon</u> Lift over Luxor.
