Its well-carved walls will help us understand the religious life that the ancient Egyptians led and the exceptional building skills of the ancient Egyptians.

Next on our <u>Aswan tours</u>, after visiting Kalabsha, will be a trip to <u>Beit El Wali</u>. This site is indeed incomparable, with wonderful inscriptions and reliefs depicting some of the major achievements of Pharaoh Ramses II. Here, one could witness the life and times of one of the most famous pharaohs in Egyptian history.

Day 3: Wadi El Sebou - Amada Temple

After a delectable breakfast aboard, you will visit <u>Wadi El Sebou</u>, an archaeological site with stunning temples constructed by Ramses II, as part of this <u>Egypt Day Tours</u> itinerary. The location, which was relocated to higher land to avoid floods from Lake Nasser, has reliefs that show the Pharaoh's triumph and devotion to the gods. Ancient and contemporary engineering achievements are demonstrated by the temples.

We then go to the <u>Amada Temple</u>, which was constructed by <u>Thutmose III</u> and dedicated to the god Amon Ra. It is among the oldest in <u>Nubia</u>. The temple's well-preserved artwork and inscriptions describe the religious rituals and god-worship of the ancient Egyptians. The temple also functions as a cultural hub reflecting spiritual life and displays the talent and skill of ancient craftspeople, especially the Nubian people during the time of Thutmose III and <u>Ramses II</u>.

Day 4: Kasr Ibrim - Abu Simbel

Enjoy a sumptuous breakfast on board while sailing to Qasr Ibrim, one of the most monument-rich sites and the entirety of Egyptian history. Once a Nubian fortress, Qasr Ibrim was home to the tombs of Nubian kings and queens from the era of Pharaoh Thutmose III. It is closed to external visits at present but still has great cultural and spiritual importance, which can be appreciated aboard. Such is the placement of the site: on the shores of the Nile, for trade and military defense against invaders in antiquity. The ruins provide interesting information about the culture and polity of the Nubian people with its fortress-tombs.

First, there is the iconic Abu Simbel, a vast temple complex commissioned by the great Pharaoh Ramses II. The larger temple has colossal statues of Ramses II standing next to the gods Amun, Ra-Horakhty, and Ptahall a testament to how closely the Pharaoh was tied to divinity. In contrast, the smaller temple is devoted to the goddess Hathor and symbolizes love and commitment between two people through Ramses II's wife, Nefertari.

In the 1960s, these temples were carefully moved to higher ground to avoid being submerged into the rising waters of Lake Nasser. This engineering marvel was crucial in the preservation of these architectural beauties for posterity to marvel at. The Temples are not only impressive due to their size and skill but also due to the fact that they symbolize Ramses II's power and religious sentiments. The big temple was oriented with the sun so that at a specific time it shines right into the inner sanctuary, which is a unique phenomenon that happens twice in a year-this is on the birthday of the Pharaoh and the anniversary of his coronation. This reflection shows the great knowledge of the ancient Egyptians in the field of astronomy and spiritualism.

Following the visit to Abu Simbel, you will return back to the cruise ship for some time to rest and contemplate upon the amazing history and magnificent architecture of this very amazing place.
