Day 1: Explore Luxor's East Bank

Day 2: Discover the West Bank - Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut's Temple

After breakfast on board, embark on a full day of exploration on Luxor's West Bank. Your Egyptologist guide will lead you to the Valley of the Kings, the final resting place of Egypt's powerful pharaohs. As you explore the elaborately decorated tombs, your guide will unravel the secrets of the ancient burial practices and the significance of the valley.

Continue to the majestic <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>, a tribute to one of Egypt's most extraordinary rulers. Known as El Deir El Bahari, this temple stands out for its unique design and the story of Queen Hatshepsut, who ruled as a pharaoh in a time when female leaders were a rarity.

Before returning to the cruise, visit the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, two massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III that have stood guard over the Theban necropolis for millennia.

Day 3: Explore Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Begin your day with a hearty breakfast on board before heading out to explore <u>Edfu's</u> famous Temple of Horus. This well-preserved temple is dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed god, who was revered as the protector of the pharaohs. Walk through the temple's grand halls and admire the detailed reliefs that depict ancient myths and religious rituals.

After your visit, return to the cruise for lunch as the ship sails toward Kom Ombo. Upon arrival, disembark to explore the unique <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, perched on a scenic bend in the Nile. This temple is unusual in that it is dedicated to two gods: Sobek, the crocodile god associated with fertility,

and Haroeris, a form of Horus. The temple's dual dedication is reflected in its symmetrical design, with twin entrances, halls, and sanctuaries.

Following your tour, continue sailing towards Aswan, enjoying a relaxing evening on board. Dinner will be served, and the night will be capped off with a traditional Nubian show, providing a vibrant taste of local culture.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing - High Dam, Unfinished Obelisk & Philae Temple

Wake up to the serene sights of Aswan as you enjoy a buffet breakfast aboard your cruise. Today's tour begins with a visit to the Aswan <u>High Dam</u>, an engineering marvel that has significantly impacted Egypt's economy by controlling the annual flooding of the Nile and generating hydroelectric power.

Next, visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, an enormous stone monument that lies in the ancient granite quarries of Aswan. Believed to have been commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut, this obelisk was never completed, providing valuable insights into the stone-carving techniques of ancient Egypt.

The day continues with a visit to the picturesque <u>Philae Temple</u>, dedicated to the goddess Isis. This temple, known for its elegant columns and intricate carvings, was relocated to its current island location following the construction of the High Dam. As you explore the temple, you'll learn about the legends of Isis and Osiris, central figures in Egyptian mythology.

After a day filled with historical wonders, return to your cruise ship for lunch and an afternoon of relaxation. Enjoy your final dinner on board, followed by another peaceful night in Aswan.

Day 5: Departure - Optional Tour of Abu Simbel
