Itinerary

Day 1: Touring the East Bank

On your first day of touring Egypt, the tour manager from Cairo Top Tours will pick you up at the airport, train station, or any Luxor hotel and drive you in an air-conditioned car to the MS Nile Radamis Nile cruise.

After enjoying a delicious buffet lunch on board, embark on an East Bank of Luxor tour led by your tour guide. First, you'll visit the magnificent <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which honors the sun god Amun-Ra, goddess Mut, and their son, the moon god Khonso. Next, you'll visit the magnificent <u>Luxor Temple</u>, one of the most well-known structures constructed during the New Kingdom era on the East Bank of the timeless river.

Take your delightful dinner for the first night aboard your Nile cruise ship with a wondrous view, while watching a very entertaining folkloric show.

Overnight in Luxor city.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner.

Day 2: West Bank Exploration (Valley of the Kings and Hatshepsut Temple)

For the most unique experience to reawaken you, how about choosing one of our optional hot air balloon rides over Luxor early in the morning? After the first excursion, an open buffet breakfast will be served on board the MS Nile Radamis Nile River Cruise. Continuing with your <u>day tours of Luxor</u>, your Egyptologist tour guide and private driver will take you for a visit to the West Bank of Luxor. The first stop is the Valley of the Kings, and it is here that you will understand how they used to build the tombs of the pharaohs. Thereafter, the <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u>, or El Deir El Bahari, will amaze you, followed by the great statues of King Amenhotep II called the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>.

After your tour, return to the cruise ship, where a delightful lunch, before raising anchor and moving towards <u>Edfu</u>. Dinner will be served as well on the cruise, and the overnight stay will be at Edfu.

Meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 3: Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

On the Nile cruise, start your day with a wonderful and fresh breakfast. After that, continue your luxury vacation to Egypt with a visit to the Temple of Horus in Edfu, where you can discover more about the god with the falcon's head who guards kingship.

Following your tour, the boat will head towards Aswan, making a stop at Kom Ombo. Here, the unusual Ptolemaic Temple of <u>Kom Ombo</u>—dedicated to the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris—will be explored by your Egyptologist guide. As you continue to travel down the Nile toward Aswan, savor a delicious lunch aboard. After dinner, you can have an entertaining evening by watching a Nubian show.

Meals: breakfast lunch, and dinner.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

Savor a delicious open buffet breakfast on the tourist's cruise to start the day. After that, your <u>Aswan</u> <u>day tour</u> will begin, starting with a visit to the magnificent High Dam, which both generates power and regulates the Nile River's water supply. Next, proceed to the incomplete obelisk, which was likely built for Queen Hatshepsut but was never finished, and is located in a granite quarry. Lastly, if time allows, pay a visit to the Greco-Roman-style <u>Philae Temple</u>, which was constructed in honor of the goddess Isis. After a full day of fun in the city of Aswan, lunch will be served on board the cruise ship, followed by a delicious dinner in the evening.

Day 5: Nile Cruise disembarkation

The magnificent <u>Abu Simbel temples</u> were constructed by King Ramses II. On your final morning, you might choose to join an optional tour of these magnificent structures. Get ready to disembark after savoring your last breakfast aboard. Your tour manager will then take you to the train station or <u>Aswan Airport</u>, which will be the conclusion of your trip to Egypt.
