Itinerary

Day 1: East Bank Exploration aboard MS Nile Radamis

Start your trip in Egypt as a Cairo tourist with Tours A representative from Top Tours meets you at the Luxor train or airport, or your Luxor hotel, and drives you in an air-conditioned car to the MS Nile Radamis cruise ship. Get started on your East Bank tour after enjoying a delicious lunch buffet onboard. See the magnificent Karnak Temple, which honors Amun-Ra, Mut, and Khonso. Next, travel to Luxor Temple, a well-known location from the New Kingdom era. Savor dinner on your first evening on the ship while taking in a mesmerizing folklore display. Spend the night at Luxor City.

Lunch and Dinner Meals

Day 2: West Bank Tours, including the Temple of Hatshepsut and the Valley of the Kings

An optional hot air balloon ride in Luxor early in the morning can be an exciting addition. Savor a breakfast buffet to start the day on the MS Nile Radamis. After that, your private driver and Egyptologist guide will lead a tour of the West Bank of Luxor, including the Valley of the Kings, where you may learn about the ancient Egyptian royal tombs. Take a tour of the enormous sculptures of King Amenhotep III, popularly known as the Colossi of Memnon, at the Hatshepsut Temple, also called El Dier El Bahari. Following the trip, get back to the cruise for lunch before the boat sets sail for Edfu. Dinner and spend the night in Edfu. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Continue your luxurious Egypt package while cruising the seas and feasting on a freshly prepared breakfast. See the Edfu Temple honoring the falcon-headed god Horus.

After that, set sail for Aswan, stopping at <u>Kom Ombo</u> to see the Ptolemaic Temple to the ancient Egyptian crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris.

Before reaching Aswan, savor lunch aboard. Dinner is provided aboard in the evening, and then a Nubian performance.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner Meals

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing

Begin your day with an open-buffet breakfast on the boat. Start your Aswan day tour with a visit to the <u>High Dam</u>, designed to control Nile water levels and generate electricity. Continue to the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, which was intended for Queen Hatshepsut but was never completed. Lastly, visit the <u>Philae Temple</u>, built in Greco-Roman style and dedicated to Isis.

Enjoy lunch while sailing on the Nile and dinner aboard the cruise, with an overnight stay in Aswan. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day Five: Departure

After your final breakfast, prepare for disembarkation from the MS Nile Radamis. If interested, you can join an optional tour of the <u>Abu Simbel temples</u>, built by Ramses II for himself and Queen Nefertari. Conclude your Egypt travel package with a transfer to <u>Aswan Airport</u> or railway station.
