Day 2: Old Cairo, Coptic Cairo

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, your day will begin with a tour of Coptic Cairo. Here, you will have the opportunity to witness the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon and visit the renowned <u>Hanging Church</u>, This church, built by early Christians on the towers of the Roman fortress, holds great historical significance. You will also explore the Church of St. Sergius, also known as the Cavern Church or the Church of the Holy Family. This church is situated above the crypt, where the Holy Family is believed to have resided for nearly three months. Make sure to visit the well that provided water supplies to the Holy Family during their stay.

Another notable stop is the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which has a fascinating story associated with it. According to legend, this synagogue is the place where the Pharaoh's daughter discovered the basket containing Moses.

Continuing the day's adventures, you will delve into the charms of Islamic Cairo. This part of the city showcases the walls and gates of the medieval city founded by the Fatimids in the 10th century.
