#### **Itinerary**

#### Day 1: Arrival in Cairo / Check-in / Overnight Stay

Our Cairo Top Tours tour guide will meet you at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> and help with arrival procedures as well as private transportation to your Giza hotel. There, your tour manager will oversee a seamless check-in process and go over your Egypt Travel Packages schedule to make sure all pick-up timings work for you.

## Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, and Old Cairo Tour

Following breakfast, you will be escorted to the Giza Pyramids by your guide, who speaks English. There, you will see the famous Great Sphinx, the Valley Temple of Chephren, the Pyramid of Mycerinus, the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, and the Middle Pyramid of Chephren. #### Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tour
