Day 2: Journey through Time: Coptic and Islamic Cairo

Let this trip take you through the historic precinct of Coptic and <u>Islamic Cairo</u> for a marvelous experience. When you wake up in the morning to the sunrise, have a good breakfast at your hotel in Cairo before you get ready for a knowledge-filled day in Cairo.

Proceed on a sightseeing tour of the Roman fortification in Babylon, where the Coptic city of Cairo is situated. Take in the spectacle of the Hanging Church, with its roots set on the towers of the Roman fortress, one of the grand manifestations of early Christianity's tenacity. The Church of St. Sergius, a.k.a. Cavern Church, or the Church of the Holy Family, is a church established on the crypt where the Holy Family stayed for three months. Visit the water well where one supplied drinking water to the Holy Family during their stay in the town and learn more about the practices of the early Christians at the place.

Then, proceed to visit <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which from the Biblical account is said to be the place where the Pharaoh's daughter was bathing when she saw the basket with the infant Moses drifting in the Nile. It is a historical Jewish house of worship that gives you a vivid experience of its dense religious background.

Moving on, learn more about the Islamic architectural marvels in Islamic Cairo. See the remains of the walls and gates of the medieval city that was founded in the 10th century, according to the Fatimids. Admire the atmosphere of Khan El Khalili bazaar, tightly connected with the elements like the markets and narrow streets, which can hide a lot.

Finally, return to your Cairo hotel and have some rest, knowing that you have seen the most historical

things in the country.

Day 3: Fly to Aswan - Aswan Tour

They will provide transportation to Aswan, and today, immediately after you are done with your breakfast, our representative will take you to the airport.
