Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Siwa

Your adventure begins as our Cairo Top Tours professional tour leader picks you up from your hotel in Cairo at 6:00 am for an unforgettable Egypt Desert Safari Tour to Siwa. Along the way, you'll have the opportunity to explore the historic El Alamein, a key site from <u>World War II</u>.

Here, you'll visit the <u>El Alamein</u> Commonwealth Cemetery, where soldiers and personnel from the Commonwealth nations who perished during the war are honored. You'll also explore the battlefield and the Second World War Museum, which offers deep insights into the war's impact on the region.

Afterward, we'll head to <u>Marsa Matrouh</u> on the stunning north coast, where you'll enjoy a delicious seafood lunch by the beach. From there, we continue our journey to Siwa, a scenic 6-hour drive from El Alamein. Upon arrival, you'll unwind with a rejuvenating bath in a natural hot water spring before settling in for the night at a charming Eco-lodge, blending comfort with the natural beauty of the oasis.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

The following morning, after enjoying a hearty breakfast, you'll continue your exploration of Siwa Oasis with an exciting Desert Safari. Your first stop will be at the ancient town of Shali, where you'll witness the remnants of this once-thriving settlement, now partially in ruins but still steeped in history. From there, you'll visit the <u>Temple of the Oracle</u>, also known as Alexander the Great's temple, located in the ancient village of Aghurmi, dating back to the 26th Dynasty.

Next, you'll explore the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> in Um Ubeyda, dedicated to the triad of gods, including the mighty Amun. Afterward, you'll step back in time at the Siwa House Museum, where you'll encounter the rich culture of the Bedouin people of Siwa. Capture the moment with lunch at one of the most picturesque spots in the oasis, either at the scenic Shali Fortress or the charming Abdo restaurant.

Your adventure continues with a visit to Cleopatra's Spring (Ein Guba), where you can take a refreshing swim and dip in the natural spring waters that have drawn visitors for centuries. As the day winds down, you'll be transferred to Fitnas Island to witness a breathtaking sunset, a perfect end to a day of exploration.

You'll spend the night in Siwa, reflecting on the incredible experiences of the day.

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

Your day begins with breakfast at the eco-lodge, setting the stage for an exciting journey into the vast expanse of the <u>Great Sand Sea</u>. Your first destination is Maraki Village, located near the towering Siwa Mountain. Here, you'll encounter the fascinating remnants of early human civilization, marked by seven fossilized coral rocks dating back to the Cambrian age, a testament to the ancient history embedded in this desert landscape.

For thrill-seekers, the adventure continues with sandboarding on the colossal dunes of the Great Sand Sea. Though the speed may not match snowboarding, the experience is equally exhilarating, especially with the right wax to glide smoothly over the golden sands. After an adrenaline-filled session, unwind with a soothing soak in the hot spring at <u>Bir Wahid</u>, where the 40-degree Celsius water will relax your muscles and refresh your spirit.

As the day draws to a close, you'll be treated to yet another mesmerizing sunset over the Great Sand Sea, a perfect end to an adventurous day.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis Tour
