Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Siwa

On your first day, your journey from Cairo to Siwa will begin with a visit to the mournful <u>El Alamein</u> Commonwealth Cemetery, where you will remember the past. Then, travel to <u>Marsa Matrouh</u> for a fantastic seafood lunch by the seaside.

Your experience continues as you take a picturesque 6-hour drive from El Alamein to the lovely Siwa Oasis. Upon arrival, unwind with a refreshing plunge in a natural hot spring before spending the night in a delightful eco-lodge where comfort meets natural beauty.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

The next day after having a very delicious breakfast, you are going to have a great experience of the Desert Safari in Siwa Oasis. The first site that you'll visit is the Shali which once used to be a prosperous town but now; it stands in the desert with some parts of it in the process of reconstruction due to its historical nature. From there, you will proceed to visit <u>Temple of the Oracle</u>, also known as Alexander the Great temple which is situated in the ancient village of Aghurmi and belongs to the 26th Dynasty.

Next, you will visit the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> in Um Ubeyda which was specific to the triad of gods which included Amun. Following that, you will visit the Siwa House Museum and here you are exposed to the culture of the Bedouin people of Siwa. Dine at one of the most beautiful location in the oasis and make your lunch at the Shali Fortress or at the beautiful Adbo restaurant.

Further on, you proceed to <u>Cleopatra's Spring</u> or also known as Ein Guba where you can also swim and take a bath in the natural spring that have been a source of fascination and attraction to many people, especially tourists for quite a while already. Day four: Early in the morning you will be taken to Nars Island you will be brought back to Fitnas Island in the evening to watch a beautiful sunset.

It will be a night's accommodation in Siwa, where you are likely to ponder on the wonderful experiences of the day.

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

As you wake up in the morning, you will have your breakfast at the ecologides with anticipation of exploring the much expansive <u>Great Sand Sea</u>. First, you will visit Maraki Village which is in the vicinity of the imposing Siwa Mountain. Here we will get to see the part of the early man and the Civilization left behind carved in seven fossilized coral rocks from the Cambrian age amidst the desert region.

Takers of risk are not left out through sandboarding on the huge dunes of the Great Sand Sea. However, it may not be as fast as snowboarding, but the feeling of gliding on the soft golden sands is just as exciting and if you choose the right wax, you glide with ease. If you are all pumped up from the action then head over to <u>Bir Wahid</u> and take a dip in the hot spring water set at 40 degrees Celsius to melt away all the tension on your muscles and get your spirits lifted.

At the end of the day, you will again enjoy a beautiful sunset over the Great Sand Sea – so beautiful, that it would be hard to imagine a better way to end the day full of excitement.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis Tour

The next part of the Siwa Oasis tour begins in the morning after having breakfast at the hotel, you will visit the Mountain of the Dead consisting of cut tombs of Kings of the 26th Dynasty, Si Amon Tombs, and the Crocodile Tombs. The next destination will be a Bedouin village of Abu Ali and during the time spent in this place, all guests will have a possibility to explore the Bedouin culture. You may also get a chance to pay a visit to a tomb which is just close by thus enriching you with another historical experience.
