Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Bahariya Oasis - White Desert

We will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo or Giza early in the morning in a comfortable; air-conditioned car to start the tour to <u>Baharya Oasis</u> and you will be accompanied by your professional tour guide. The

beautiful green environment is around and near before to get to the historical desert when one goes near the area of the oasis.

The first Interesting Place is called <u>Valley of the Golden Mummies</u> in which ten Royal mummies provide that important final touch on the burial process. From here one can freely walk within the territory of the <u>Tombs of the Nobles</u> and the name suits the status of the ancient Bahariya upper class well. Amongst all these tombs, the Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh tomb and the Bannentiu tomb are illustrated as famous as these tombs cumulated generations of burial extensions, symbolizing the deducing cultures of such regions.

After that, he proceeded to the temple of Alexander the Great, where Bibliography is believed to have slept en route to the Siwa Oasis. Initially, the Temple of Ain El-Mefetla was identified as belonging to the <u>26th</u> <u>Dynasty</u> Although further exploration has shown that this temple has five chapels that served an especially significant role in ascertaining the importance of this cult icon.

The special about this site is that around this landscape there are so many places where one can take gorgeous and enthralling photos and simply appreciate the creations of Mother Nature.

However, before Cairo, there is Bahariya Oasis, an oasis in the middle of the desert, and a green desert island in the middle of dunes. On the way, one can visit the <u>Black Desert</u> whose surface is covered with small black volcanic stones after which this territory is named. You will also be able to visit some other parts like the saltwater lavatory and Worksheet about the dunes Besides the account of the Bedouin guide telling more about the area and the other attractions.
