<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Cairo - Bahariya Oasis - White Desert

When you start your tour from Cairo or Giza, on the first day only, you will witness the enigmas of <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>. This is organized by our local Bedouin guide who is to come and pick you up from the hotel in the morning; You will be driven in a comfortably air-conditioned car through what appears to be a greenish area of the oasis.

To examine the usage of the Egyptian necropolis, the tour begins at the <u>Valley of the Golden Mummies</u> to view ten great royal mummies. Then pay the nobles' tombs – indeed, it is one of the most frequented archeological sights about what type of importance the founders of the oasis possessed and what they built for themselves. We also have the zed Amun of Ankh tomb and there is also the tom of Bannentiu.

The second activity on the list is the <u>temple of Alexander</u>, which was constructed to show the halt before progressing to Siwa Oasis. The final site will be the temple of Ain El-Mefetla which belongs to the 26th Egyptian dynasty. Nevertheless, at each epoch, the construction of the temple was provided with more additional rooms.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 2: Back to Cairo

Enjoy Bedouin breakfast an hour to the sunrise; and tea while meeting the Desert view. Unlike a conventional breakfast where one has to cook, one can take them at any time in consideration of the fact the horizon appears lighter whenever there is orange in the sky, meaning that it is dawn. With your visit, we start with hot springs and then get refreshed enough to enjoy the view of this peculiar White desert. Maps may stand out but not as attractively: wave action and wind over the many millennia have polished outstanding eerie mushroom and rabbit limestone shapes.

Continue with the tour of desert safari from Bahariya Oasis which is the longest, central-east desert in Egypt; <u>black desert</u> features black sand. Here, It volcanic stones in conjunction with rugged mountains; If not else that of otherworldly look. But the last is to plan that your tour should end in Salt Lake and the Dunes which offer at least glimpses of green in the backdrop of Egyptian desert which this region of Egypt lacks.

Ultimately, in the last part of the desert trip, your guide will take you to a bus station, and from there you proceed with the Cairo trip feeling the Egyptian deserts.
