Day 1 : Arrival to Cairo and check in

Overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 2: Explore the Pyramids

Begin your day with a sumptuous gourmet breakfast at your Cairo hotel before embarking on an unforgettable exploration of <u>the Pyramids of Giza</u> with our expert guide. Visit the awe-inspiring Great Pyramid of Cheops, where you can explore its interior or take spectacular photos while learning about its storied past. Continue to the Pyramid of King Chephren, notable for its slightly smaller stature and proximity to the iconic Great Sphinx, a massive lion-headed statue.

Admire the Pyramid of King Mycerinus, the smallest of the trio, with optional camel rides offering unique photo opportunities. Discover the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, carved from a single stone and standing as a symbol of strength and wisdom. Explore <u>the Valley Temple</u>, an ancient site used for the Pharaoh's afterlife rituals. After a brief drive to Memphis, the ancient capital, delve into its historical treasures.

Conclude your day at the <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u>, home to the impressive Step Pyramid of King Djoser and other significant tombs. Enjoy a delightful lunch in Saqqara before returning to your Giza hotel for a well-deserved rest. Meals included: breakfast and lunch.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum and Cairo Tour

At the hotel, begin your day with a filling breakfast as you prepare to learn more about your <u>Egypt</u> <u>Classic Tours</u>. Your authorized guide will first take you to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, which is well-known for its vast collection of Egyptian artifacts, which includes the well-known Tutankhamun riches exhibited over two levels. See the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, a magnificent specimen of Ottoman architecture, when you next head to <u>the Citadel of Saladin</u>.

Discover the allure of <u>Islamic Cairo</u>, adorned with imposing buildings, colorful domes, and historic mosques. Visit the Roman fortification of Babylon in Coptic Cairo, as well as <u>the Hanging Church</u> of the Holy Virgin Mary, which was constructed above the towers of the citadel. See <u>the Ben Ezra</u> <u>Synagogue</u>, which is thought to be the location of infant Moses' discovery, and the Church of St. Sergius, which is situated above the crypt where the Holy Family is rumored to have sought refuge. Following a delectable lunch, go on your trip by visiting the historical Cairo bazaar, <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, and meandering through its atmospheric gates and streets. Head back to your hotel for the night. There were two meals: breakfast and lunch.

Day 4: Alexandria sightseeing tour

After breakfast, meet your English-speaking Egyptologist guide for a day trip to <u>Alexandria</u>. You'll travel in an air-conditioned vehicle.

Upon arriving in Alexandria, explore the city's highlights, starting with Pompey's Pillar, built in 297

B.C. to commemorate a Roman victory. Next, visit the <u>Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa</u>, one of the largest Roman burial sites, and then head to the <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, which stands on the site of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria.

Discover <u>the Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u>, once the world's largest library, founded in the 3rd century B.C. Enjoy a delicious seafood lunch before returning to your Cairo hotel. Meals included: Breakfast and lunch.
