Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, a certified representative from Cairo Top Tours will be

there to greet you with a sign displaying your name. You'll be escorted in a private vehicle to your hotel in Giza or Cairo. After checking in, we'll review your Tours itinerary to confirm all the pick-up times for your tours in Cairo and other cities.

Day 2: Things to Do in Cairo, the Sphinx, and the Giza Pyramids

Day 3: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

Upon arrival, you'll visit the Valley of the Golden Mummies, discovered by chance when a donkey fell into a hole, leading to the unearthing of thousands of Roman-era mummies adorned in gold. You'll also explore the Tombs of the Nobles and the Temple of Alexander the Great, although natural erosion has caused partial damage to the temple's inscriptions and carvings. Another highlight is the Temple of Ein El Meffetla, believed to be the center of the ancient city of Al Qasr.

Enjoy lunch at the oasis before checking into your hotel. In the afternoon, take a relaxing dip in the mineral-rich hot springs. Later, as the sun sets, you'll have the chance to explore the oasis, meet the locals, and learn about their unique traditions. Climb the Black Mountain for panoramic views of the oasis and its stunning sunset, making the hike truly worthwhile.

Overnight stay in Bahariya Oasis.

Day 4: The White & Black Desert Adventure

After breakfast, your adventure begins with a visit to Bahariya's salt lake and the majestic dunes. Explore the lush palm tree groves and local fruit gardens before enjoying lunch. You'll then head to the <u>Black Desert</u>, known for its volcanic rock formations and striking black-colored mountains. The journey continues to Crystal Mountain and the Valley of Agabat, with a stop at the Valley of El Haize.

Your day culminates with an excursion into the <u>White Desert</u>, famous for its unique chalk formations sculpted by years of wind and sandstorms. The surreal shapes and landscapes here are unlike anything you've ever seen. Spend the night camping under the stars in the White Desert, where you may even spot the elusive desert fox. As you watch the sunset, your local Bedouin guides will prepare a fresh, authentic dinner.

Day 5: Return to Cairo

Following a customary breakfast cooked by your Bedouin hosts, you'll have time to unwind and snap

pictures of the breathtaking vista of the White Desert. You'll stop at the hot springs for a cooling plunge before heading back to Cairo.
