<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo & Visit to Saqqara and Dahshur Pyramids

Upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will assist with your passport and luggage.

Begin your **Cairo day tour** by visiting the famous <u>Giza Pyramids</u> and the Sphinx, with a detailed introduction from your guide.

Continue to <u>Saqqara</u> to see the Step Pyramid of King Djoser, then enjoy lunch before heading to <u>Dahshur</u> to visit the Bent Pyramid and the <u>Red Pyramid</u> of King Senefru.

End the day exploring the ancient city of <u>Memphis</u>, home to a massive statue of Ramses II. After the tour, check into your hotel.

Day 02: Alexandria Day Tour

After enjoying your breakfast, you will meet your guide and your driver to start your tour to the most famous historic sites of Alexandria, which were built by Alexander the Great in 332 BC.

First, you will visit the <u>Kom El Shoqafa catacombs</u>, Pompey's pillar, and the <u>citadel of Qaitbay</u>, which was built on the remains of the ancient lighthouse of Alexandria.

Indulge in a lavish seafood-lined lunch and visit the contemporary <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u>.

Walk around the city and its courtyards as well as points of interest before heading back to Cairo for the night.

Day 3 Cario Tour

After breakfast, commence a journey to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> of Antiquities to enjoy some time going through its numerous artifacts, including the King Tutankhamun treasures.

Afterward, proceed to the <u>citadel of Saladin</u> and that of Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque.

Lunch will be served, after which a tour will be done in <u>Coptic Cairo</u> to include the Hanging Church, <u>St. Sergius' Church</u>, and Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Finally, move on to <u>Islamic Cairo</u>, take a walk down El Moez Street, and visit the Azhar mosque and Khan El Khalili bazaar.

Have some time at the <u>El Fishawy cafe</u> before going back to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 04: Cairo to Luxor

After breakfast, you will check out from the hotel. You will be transferred to Cairo Airport as arranged to take your flight to Luxor. Upon arrival, you will start your West Bank tour which includes the <u>Valley</u>

of the Kings, where you will explore the three royal tombs and the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u>. You will also see the Colossi of Memnon.

In the afternoon after lunch, the East Bank tour commences at the <u>Karnak Temple</u>, also known as the walking along Avenue of the Sphinxes and the Luxor Temple.

Optional: Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple.

Overnight stay in Luxor.

Dietary: Breakfast and lunch

Day 5: Luxor To Aswan

Once you have finished breakfast and checked out of the facility early, you will start your road trip from Luxor to Aswan.

Commence the sightseeing in Aswan with the <u>High Dam</u>, which is one of the engineering wonders of the world and a great contributor to the economy of Egypt. Then, enjoy a boat ride to the <u>Philae</u> <u>Temple</u>, which has buildings built from different periods, such as the Temple of Isis.

After lunch, you will be given rooms at the hotel where you will stay in Aswan.

Day 6: Abu Simbel to Cairo

Upon concluding the breakfast, you will proceed to visit the <u>Abu Simbel</u> temples, which are the temples built by Ramses II in honor of himself and his wife. Finish visiting the temples and return back to Aswan by early afternoon.

Then you will be driven to Aswan airport in order to catch your flight back to Cairo, where a representative will be waiting to welcome you and assist you to check into your hotel.

Day 07: Final Departure

Have your last breakfast in the hotel. If there is time, you may consider a day tour in Cairo. At the appropriate time, our representative will take you to Cairo International Airport for your flight.
