## Day 1: Getting to Cairo and settling down

Your name will be displayed on a signboard inside <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, where the Cairo Top Tours tour guide will be waiting for you when your flight lands. He will drive you to your Giza hotel in a

nice, private, air-conditioned car. Make sure to update the <u>Egypt Classic Tours</u> from Cairo to Alexandria vacation schedule for all pick-up times after you arrive at the hotel and settle into your room after our representative helps you with a seamless check-in.

Stay the night in Cairo. We'll be serving welcome drinks.

#### **Day 2: Tour of the Pyramids**

Start your day with a gourmet breakfast at your Cairo hotel before meeting your certified tour guide for an immersive <u>Giza pyramids</u> tour. Begin with the Great Pyramid of Cheops, built 4,500 years ago, where you can explore inside or take photos while learning about its history.

Next, visit the slightly smaller Pyramid of Chephren, built by Cheops' son, and the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, a monumental figure carved from a single stone. Continue to the Pyramid of Mycerinus, the smallest of the three, and enjoy an optional camel ride for stunning photos. Explore <u>the Valley Temple</u>, known for its ancient rituals, before traveling 35 minutes to Memphis to visit its open-air museum and discover artifacts from Egypt's oldest capital.

Proceed to Saqqara, where you'll see the <u>Step Pyramid</u> of King Djoser, the oldest stone building, and explore the pyramid of Teti with its hieroglyphic inscriptions. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in <u>Saqqara</u> before returning to your hotel in Giza for the night. Meals included: Breakfast and lunch.

## Day 3: Tour of Cairo and the Egyptian Museum

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before embarking on another day of your Egypt Classic Tours. Your licensed guide will first take you to the Egyptian Museum, renowned globally for its extensive collection of Egyptian artifacts spread across two floors, including the famed royal treasures of Tutankhamun. Next, visit the Citadel of Saladin, once the heart of Egyptian governance, and explore the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, a stunning example of Ottoman architecture in Egypt. Discover Islamic Cairo's rich history as you admire its numerous ancient mosques and towering minarets, many of which are over a thousand years old.

On our Coptic Cairo tour, you'll explore the Roman fortress of Babylon and the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, also known as Al Mualaka, which was built atop the fortress's towers. During your Cairo Day Tours, visit the Church of St. Sergius, constructed over the crypt where the Holy Family is said to have stayed and where they sourced their water. Next, see the Ben Ezra Synagogue, traditionally believed to be the site where the basket of baby Moses was discovered. After a delightful lunch, continue your Islamic Cairo exploration with a visit to the Khan El Khalili bazaar in the heart of medieval Cairo. Discover the ancient walls, gates, and streets dating back to the 10th century. Your representative will then return you to your hotel for the night in Cairo.

## Day 4: Tour of Alexandria's sights

After breakfast, meet your expert English-speaking Egyptologist guide for a <u>day trip to Alexandria</u> from Cairo as part of our Egypt Classic Tours. You'll travel by air-conditioned vehicle, with a break en route, arriving in Alexandria—the sparkling Mediterranean jewel and Egypt's second capital, founded by Alexander. Begin your tour at <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, then explore the <u>Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa</u>, one of the largest Roman burial sites. Continue along the coast to the <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, built on the site of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria. Visit the <u>Bibliotheca Alexandrina</u>, the historic center of global scientific research established in the 3rd century B.C. by Ptolemy I. Enjoy a seafood lunch featuring the freshest local ingredients before returning to your Cairo hotel.
