Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Siwa

Cairo Top Tours professional tour leader will meet you at the hotel in Cairo at 8:00 pm to start your great Egypt Desert Safari Tours to Siwa. Then the El Alamein tour from Cairo starts at the Cemeteries of World War II.

We shall visit the <u>El Alamein Commonwealth</u> the organization that is entitled to the establishment and management of Burial grounds and memorials both military and Civil, the battle site, and the War Museum.

Then proceed to the magnificent <u>Marsa Matrouh</u> on the North Coast where you will have your delicious seafood lunch then head for desert and drive to the oasis town of Siwa, which takes about 6 hour's drive from El Alamein. Take a dip in a hot water spring before being moved to the hotel for a stay in an aesthetic Eco-lodge.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

After breakfast, your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari will go on yet you will be taken to visit the remaining part of the old town of Siwa or Shali has been melted down partly then proceed and visit The Temple that was dedicated to <u>Alexander the Great</u> the Oracle a Temple in the village of Aghurmi, which belongs to the 26th Dynasty.

Still, the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> at Um Ubeyda which had been built in honor of the triad of Amun has to be continued Then continue the Siwan heritage through the <u>Siwa House Museum</u> to view the cruelties of the Bedouin tribes in Siwa and after that will have their lunch in the Oasis popular square overviewing the Shali at Abdo restaurant.

Afternoon relaxed in <u>Cleopatra Spring</u> (Ein Guba) we will swim and bathe in the crystal water then transfer to Fitnas island to witness the breathtaking sunset.

Overnight in Siwa. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

Breakfast in the great Organic House at our eco-lodge – a great base for the <u>Great Sand Sea</u> tour First, you will visit the archeological place at Maraki village – the first footprint of the humans ever found in the world on the Great Siwa Mountain, then continue the Safari through the dunes of Siwa oasis till you reach the fossils area to have a look at the rocky coral reefs of camel age.

Get to one of the interesting places in the great sand sea a beautiful lake in the middle of the desert it is also opting to see the flamingo birds, and take a bath in the cold water of the lake taking a bath in the captivating desert.

Then get excited by the <u>sandboarding</u> experience, not anything like snowboarding but if you use the right wax, you can sals away down some of the huge dunes of the great sand sea and have stunts to spare, after so much sandboarding it is time to wash up in the hot springs called <u>Bir Wahid</u> relax our muscles in 40-degree warm water, enjoy another spectacular Sun Set in the middle of the sand sea while having Bed.

Overnight in Siwa overnight.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis Trip

The Siwa Oasis Adventure begins with a breakfast at an eco-lodge and then explores the <u>Mountain of</u> <u>the Dead</u>, a historical site with ancient rock-cut tombs dating back to the <u>Twenty-Sixth Dynasty</u> of Egypt. These tombs, including the tomb of Si Amon and the crocodile tomb, showcase the burial practices and beliefs of the ancient Siwan people. The tombs are known for their intricate decorations and crocodile-shaped carvings, reflecting the reverence for the creature in ancient times.

Then exploring the Mountain of the Dead, the adventure continues to the Bedouin village of Abu Ali, where visitors can witness the Bedouin people's way of life in the desert. They learn about their customs, craftsmanship, and simplicity of desert living, and may even participate in a tea ceremony.

After a relaxing evening at the hotel in Siwa, the day's adventures are reflected in the tranquil desert oasis, allowing for another peaceful night before continuing with more exploration. the first full moon of October. Back to your hotel and overnight in Siwa.
