<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Cairo - Siwa

Our professional tour leader from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will meet you at your hotel in Cairo at 8:00 pm. We then head west toward the fascinating and serene <u>Siwa Oasis</u>, passing through the historic El Alamein World War II battlegrounds along the way.

You will have the opportunity to visit the Commonwealth <u>El Alamein War Cemetery</u>, a deeply moving site dedicated to the soldiers who lost their lives in one of the war's most significant battles. We will also visit the battle site and the El Alamein War Museum, where you'll gain insight into the war through the well-curated exhibits.

We continue our journey to the stunning coastal town of <u>Marsa Matrouh</u>. Here, you can enjoy a seafood lunch by the Mediterranean Sea, soaking in the breathtaking ocean views. After a few hours of relaxing by the coast, we head deeper into the desert toward Siwa.

Upon reaching the peaceful town of Siwa, you may take a refreshing bath in a natural hot spring. Finally, we will arrive at our eco-friendly lodge, where you can fully immerse yourself in the tranquility and beauty of Siwa.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

After breakfast, your Siwa Oasis Desert Safari will start. You will be taken to visit the remaining part of the old town of Siwa or Shali, which has been melted down partly. You will visit The Temple of <u>Alexander the Great</u>, which is called also the Oracle Temple. This temple is located in the village of Aghurmi and was built in the 26th Dynasty.

You will visit the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> at Um Ubeyda which had been built in honor of the triad of Amun. You will see the Siwan heritage through the <u>Siwa House Museum</u> to learn more about the traditions of the Bedouin tribes in Siwa and after that will have a delicious lunch in the Oasis popular square overviewing the Shali at Abdo restaurant.

Afternoon relaxed in <u>Cleopatra Spring</u> (Ein Guba) we will swim and bathe in the crystal water then transfer to Fitnas island to witness the breathtaking sunset.

Overnight in Siwa.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed

Breakfast in the great Organic House at our eco-lodge – a great base for the <u>Great Sand Sea</u> tour First, you will visit the archeological place at Maraki village – the first footprint of the humans ever found in the world on the Great Siwa Mountain, then continue the Safari through the dunes of Siwa oasis till you reach the fossils area to have a look at the rocky coral reefs of camel age.

Get to one of the interesting places in the great sand sea a beautiful lake in the middle of the desert and take a bath in the cold water of the lake taking a bath in the captivating desert. Then get excited by the <u>sandboarding</u> experience—not anything like snowboarding, but if you use the right wax, you can sail away down some of the huge dunes of the great sand sea and have stunts to spare. After so much sandboarding, it is time to wash up in the hot springs called <u>Bir Wahid</u>, relax our muscles in 40-degree warm water, and enjoy another spectacular sunset in the middle of the sand sea while having a bed.

Overnight in Siwa overnight.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis Trip

The Siwa Oasis Adventure begins with a breakfast at an eco-lodge and then explores the <u>Mountain of the Dead</u>, a historical site with ancient rock-cut tombs dating back to the <u>Twenty-Sixth Dynasty</u> of Egypt. These tombs, including the tomb of Si Amon and the crocodile tomb, showcase the burial practices and beliefs of the ancient Siwan people. The tombs are known for their intricate decorations and crocodile-shaped carvings, reflecting the reverence for the creature in ancient times.

Then exploring the Mountain of the Dead, the adventure continues to the Bedouin village of Abu Ali, where visitors can witness the Bedouin people's way of life in the desert. They learn about their customs, craftsmanship, and simplicity of desert living, and may even participate in a tea ceremony.

After a relaxing evening at the hotel in Siwa, the day's adventures are reflected in the tranquil desert oasis, allowing for another peaceful night before continuing with more exploration. the first full moon of October. Back to your hotel and overnight in Siwa.

Day 5: Final Departure
