#### **Itinerary**

#### Day 1: A Trip in Luxor

Start your journey by boarding your opulent Nile cruise ship in Luxor. You'll begin your exploration of Luxor's historical treasures once you've settled into your chic cabin with panoramic views. Learn about the temple's fascinating history and its dual dedication to two deities. Later in the afternoon, return to the ship for dinner and enjoy an evening of onboard entertainment. In the morning, visit the <u>Temple of Horus</u> at Edfu, the best-preserved cult temple in Egypt, dedicated to the falcon god Horus.

### Day 4: A trip from Kom Ombo to Aswan

Early in the morning, set sail for Aswan. Once there, venture on a boat excursion to the enchanted <a href="Philae Temple">Philae Temple</a>, honoring the goddess Isis. This temple complex is a real treasure of ancient Egyptian architecture, having been moved to Agilkia Island. After that, pay a visit to the well-known <a href="Unfinished Obelisk">Unfinished Obelisk</a>, a massive granite sculpture that provides insight into ancient Egyptian stone-making methods. Proceed to the Aswan <a href="High Dam">High Dam</a>, a contemporary wonder that has greatly impacted Egypt's agriculture and economy. taste a delicious dinner after seeing a traditional Nubian show onboard in the evening.

## **Day 5: Departure from Aswan**

On your last day, take a leisurely felucca sailboat tour around the Aswan islands, giving you time to take in the tranquil beauty of the Nile and its environs. Bid farewell to the ship and your fellow passengers after breakfast.
