Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Bahariya Oasis - White Desert

On the first day of your tour from Cairo or Giza, you will see the mysteries of Bahariya Oasis. You will be picked up from your hotel in the morning and driven in a comfortable, air-conditioned car by our local Bedouin guide through the greenery of the oasis.

The trip starts in the <u>Valley of the Golden Mummies</u> where ten outstanding royal mummies give insight into Egyptian burial traditions. Then proceed to the nobles' tombs-the rich archaeological site that provides a glimpse into the social and architectural clout of the early leaders of the oasis. These are the enigmatic Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh tomb and Bannentiu tomb.

After that, go to the temple of Alexander the Great which was built to mark his halt before proceeding to Siwa Oasis. The last stop is going to be the <u>temple of Ain El-Mefetla</u> which belongs to the 26th dynasty of Egypt and was constricted with added rooms throughout the epochs.

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Day 2: Back to Cairo

Have a marvelous traditional Bedouin breakfast just an hour before sunrise with tea while watching the stunning view of the desert. There is also no need to wake up early because breakfast is served when the horizon starts turning orange with dawn. With your visit start with the hot springs to rejuvenate yourselves before you venture into the magical White Desert. Over millions of years, wind has carved outstanding eerie limestone formations into mushroom and rabbit shapes.

Carry on the trip from Bahariya Oasis – a green desert, which is located in the central-eastern part of Egypt – to <u>Black Desert</u>, which is famous for its black sands. Here, volcanic stones in concomitant to rugged mountains; If not Of else otherworldly appearance. Last but not least you can arrange to end your tour with salt lake and dunes through which the travelers can have a glimpse of the non-lush greenery of Egypt.

At the end of the desert trip, your guide will take you to the bus station to get back to Cairo with memorable memories of the deserts of Egypt.
