Itinerary

Day 1: Cairo - Siwa

Your Cairo Top Tours professional guide will pick you up from your hotel in Cairo then proceed to enjoy Egypt Desert Safari Tour to Siwa Oasis starting at 6:00 AM. The trip begins with World War II Cemeteries in El Alamein where one will get to pay respect to the commonwealth's <u>World War II</u> heroes. The historic battle site you will visit as well as the rather engaging World War II Museum will help open your eyes to this period.

Then we proceed to Marsa Matrouh – a charming small town on the North Coast of Egypt; here you have a seafood lunch at the restaurants on the seashore. Next, it is possible to proceed to Siwa which lies four hundred and five kilometers southwest of El Alamein and it takes six hours by car. Following a phenomenal drive in, feel the opportunity to boost your spirits by taking a soak in one of the natural hot springs available before being transported to your eco-lodge for an overnight stay; this is a serene village.

Day 2: Siwa Sightseeing

A wonderful breakfast awaits before you get down for the thrilling Desert Safari which is organized in Siwa Oasis. The first destination will be the historic town of Shali which was an important inhabitant town in the past, currently remaining as an important historical structure represented in the desert. Some of it is undergoing renovation since it is an ancient structure. From there you will proceed to Alexander the Great temple or the Temple of Oracle which is found in Aghurmi an ancient village that can be dated back to the 26th Dynasty.

The next destination is that you will visit the <u>Temple of Amun Ra</u> in Um Ubeyda which is specifically for the triad of gods of which Amun is included. You will also touch the Siwa House Museum, you get acquainted with the culture and customs of the Siwa Bedouins. Taste a really extraordinary meal at amidst the beautiful scenery of the oasis either in the Shali Fortress or in Adbo Restaurant.

Next, go and explore the <u>Cleopatra Spring</u> also known as Ein Guba, with clear waters of natural spring that is a sight to behold commonly for travelers who want tour take a bath.

On day four, for instance, you can take breakfast at Nars Island, which is quiet and beautiful to spend the morning before you proceed to Fitnas Island to enjoy the sunset. While you are drifting away in the serene village of Siwa in the evening you make good time to ponder over the wonderful events of the day.

Day 3: Shiata - Great Sand Sea - Bir Wahed tour

In the morning when you wake up have your breakfast at the eco-lodge while anticipating the day's adventure in the <u>Great Sand Sea</u>. First, you will visit Maraki Village on the foothills of the splendid Siwa Mountain. Here, you will find numerous relics of early man, there are seven fossils of coral rocks from the

Cambrian age now surrounded and merged with the sands of the desert.

For those who enjoy some extra adrenaline, there is sandboarding on the massive dunes of the Great Sand Sea. It is not as fast-moving as snowboarding, however, having the feeling of sledding down the soft yellow sand is an experience on its own. Thus, choosing the correct wax will make it very easy for you to move when on the dunes and will make the ride even more fun.

Once the rush is over take a break and soothe your bones and soul in the hot spring water of <u>Bir Wahid</u> with water whose temperature is a comfortable 40 degrees celsius.

Towards the evening, one is able to see a beautiful sunset over the Great Sand Sea and thus ending a very spectacular day.

Day 4: Siwa Oasis

Apart from the delicious breakfast in the eco-lodge, you will proceed with your day tour in Siwa Oasis. Your first visit will be to the rock-cut tombs that are located in the Mountain of the Dead (Jabal EL Mawta), known also as the Tombs of the Kings, on the western side of the outskirts of the town, where you will be visiting the tombs of the kings of the 26th Dynasty namely the tomb of Si-Amun or the Crocodile Tomb. These archaeological sites give the visitors a peek of the historical past of Siwa and how it was associated with the Egyptian ancient civilization.

Then, proceed to the Bedouin village of Abu Ali, where guests will be able to know the Bedouin style and setting. Learn about less traditional facets of it as a one-class school and other cultural attractions. You will also be able to take a tour to the Burial Place of Alexander III of Macedonia also referred to as Alexander the Great.

Next, go back to the city of Siwa to explore <u>Dakrour Mountain</u> where the people of that area hold the Tourism Festival of El Syaha in the first full moon of October. As was established earlier, this site has a very significant cultural value for the Siwi people.

Finally, after exploring the sites in Aghur, return to the hotel you will be using in Siwa for relaxation and dinner before the following day activities.
