Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo and Check-in

Day 2: Tour of the Giza Pyramids

Begin your day with a delicious breakfast at your Cairo hotel, then meet your certified tour guide to embark on a fascinating exploration of the Giza Plateau:

The Great Pyramid of Cheops: Explore this ancient wonder, built over 4,500 years ago during the Old Kingdom. Enjoy free time to enter the pyramid or take photographs as your guide recounts its incredible history.

<u>Memphis</u>: Travel to Memphis, the historic capital of Egypt, and explore the open-air museum showcasing artifacts from this ancient city, founded by King Menes.

Saqqara Necropolis: Continue to <u>Saqqara</u>, one of the world's oldest and richest archaeological sites. Visit the Step Pyramid of Djoser, designed by Imhotep, and the Pyramid of Teti with its hieroglyphic inscriptions. Explore one of the Mastaba tombs, featuring vibrant depictions of daily life.

After a fulfilling day of sightseeing, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Saqqara before returning to your Giza hotel for the evening.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum and Cairo City Tour

Begin your day with a hearty breakfast at the hotel, then prepare for another fascinating day on your Egypt Classic Tours. Your expert guide will lead you to the Egyptian Museum, a world-renowned institution housing an extensive collection of Egyptian antiquities across two floors. Among the

highlights is the impressive royal treasure of Tutankhamun, displayed in a dedicated exhibit.

Next, visit the <u>Citadel of Saladin</u>, a historic fortress that served as the seat of the Egyptian government for centuries. Here, you'll explore the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, an exquisite example of Ottoman architecture in Egypt. As you journey through Islamic Cairo, admire the numerous mosques, towers, and colorful domes that punctuate the skyline, some of which date back over a thousand years.

The tour continues in <u>Coptic Cairo</u>, where you'll see the Roman Fortress of Babylon and the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, also known as Al Mualaka, situated above the fortress towers. Visit the Church of St. Sergius, built over the crypt where the Holy Family is said to have stayed during their flight into Egypt, and the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, traditionally believed to be the site where the baby Moses was found.

Enjoy a delicious lunch before heading to the bustling <u>Khan El Khalili</u> Bazaar, located in the heart of medieval Islamic Cairo. Explore the ancient streets, walls, and gates of the city, which date back to the 10th century.

After a day filled with exploration, your representative will return you to your hotel for an overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 4: Alexandria Sightseeing Tour

Next, explore the <u>Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa</u>, a vast Roman burial site discovered in the early 20th century.

Continue your tour with a visit to <u>the Citadel of Qaitbay</u>, situated on a narrow peninsula at the entrance of Alexandria's Eastern Port. This fortress was built on the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

Next, head to the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a modern tribute to the ancient Library of Alexandria, which was once the world's largest repository of knowledge. Located by the Mediterranean, it was established in the early 3rd century B.C. by Ptolemy I.

No trip to Alexandria is complete without savoring its renowned seafood. Enjoy a delicious lunch featuring the freshest local ingredients.

After a day full of historical and cultural exploration, you will be driven back to your hotel in Cairo.
