<u>Itinerary</u>

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Begin your <u>Egypt luxury tour</u> with the good feeling of exploring Egypt. At <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, one of our representatives will greet you and help you go through all the arrival formalities up to the possession of your luggage. You will then be driven to your four- or five-star hotel in Cairo and introduced to your private tour manager. They will look at your Egypt budget tour itinerary and tell you what check-in time to expect.

When you get to your hotel, you will have some time to relax before you prepare for the morning tour of Cairo. Visiting the capital city, which boasts great historical and cultural attractions, is always an exciting experience. Go sightseeing for great attractions, including the great pyramids of Giza, Cheops, and the great pyramid of Giza, including the mysterious Sphinx.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, the Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo Tour

Have a great breakfast in the hotel's main restaurant before becoming acquainted with your experienced tour guide. Begin your sightseeing by visiting the Great Pyramid of Cheops, which is a one-of-a-kind structure that took more than two decades to complete.

The ancient kings Chephren and Mycerinus of the same dynasty should be viewed in the context of the architectural ensembles of their funerary pyramids. Stare in wonder at the spectacular Sphinx, from where a human-faced lion guards the Necropolis. Take amazing photos and have the chance to add a bit of a twist—a camel ride—to your visit to the Pyramids. You will then go to the Valley Temple of King Chephren, which is another marvelous temple solely for the mummification process, and you will be amazed to see that most of its floor is made up of white alabaster tiles extracted from Aswan.

Subsequently, the tour proceeds to Coptic Cairo to visit Babylon—the ancient fort, the Hanging Church, which has been constructed in a hanging manner from its high towers and has chosen an excellent location—and Saint Sergius Church, which is also very beautiful. Sergius, or The Cave Church, or Church of the Holy Family, is located above the cave where the Holy Family was sheltering for nearly three months, near the well where they stored the water. Your explorations of Coptic Cairo continue up to the time you tour the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is believed to house the castle from which the pharaoh's daughter fetched Moses from the Nile.

In the afternoon after lunch, you are advised to be driven to the area of Islamic Cairo. During your travels towards Islamic Cairo, you will do everything possible to have a mint tea in Al-Fishawy, which is one of the oldest coffee shops found in Khan el Khalili Bazaar.

Day 3: Luxor East Bank Tours

Leave your hotel early in the morning after breakfast to Cairo airport for a flight to Luxor, on arrival, one of our professional Egypt Nile cruise tour representatives will be waiting for you as usual in our Egypt day tours or Egypt tour packages and then transferred aboard the 5-star Egypt Nile cruise Steinberger MS Minerva or similar. Again, after the first lunch on board the ship, start the sailing tour to discover the east bank of Luxor and select your first place of visit as Karnak Temple, the largest religious temple complex in the world, other than being the central place from which a big empire such as Egypt was controlled. Stop also at the Luxor Temple, which will be very nice and beautiful at night.

From here, you are washed, and driven back to the ship, and then dinner will be served on the cruise.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor - Edfu

You will be provided with a buffet breakfast on board your Nile cruise ship, and then a dedicated Egyptologist guide will escort you to the west bank of the river to visit two statues of Amenhotep III labeled as The Colossi of Memnon. After that, you will be astounded by the necropolis of the Valley of Kings, where over 62 New Kingdom pharaohs were buried, including the famous pharaoh Tutankhamun and Ramses Buried in the rocks, the tombs are beautifully painted inside and out and filled with treasures for the pharaohs to use in the afterlife after they get revived by the sun. Your Luxor day tours will move on to the Temple of Hatshepsut, meaning El Deir El Bahari; she was the first female Pharaoh in Egyptian history.

For lunch, diners will have a tasty lunch, then the ship will set sail for <u>Edfu</u>, where dinner and a show will take place on the ship.

Day 5: The temple of Edfu - Kom Ombo

Visit the Edfu falcon-headed temple, a well-preserved Ptolemaic temple dedicated to the god Horus, following another oriental breakfast in the main restaurant of the Nile Cruise. Set sail for Kom Ombo and explore the fascinating <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, honoring the god of the crocodile, Sobek. Enjoy lunch on the ship, set sail for Aswan before dinner, and enjoy the evening on your opulent Nile cruise.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served.

Day 6: Aswan Sightseeing Tours

After breakfast on the Nile cruise, you will be driven to the Unfinished Obelisk, the largest known obelisk found in the <u>Aswan day tour</u> granite quarries, and then to the magnificent temple of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis and beautifully situated on an island. The <u>High Dam</u> is an engineering marvel and the most significant project in modern Egypt. Returning to the boat, savor your meal and spend the night there.

Day 7: Back to Cairo

After breakfast, disembark from the Steigenberger MS Minerva Nile cruise or similar and head to the <u>airport in Aswan</u> to catch your aircraft back to Cairo.
