<u>Itinerary</u>

#### **Day 1: Travel to Aswan**

Your journey begins with a certified tour guide meeting you at your hotel in Aswan, <u>Aswan Airport</u>, or the railway station. From there, you'll embark on a 4-day Nile River Cruise from Aswan to Luxor aboard a 5-star Egypt Nile River Cruise. Upon boarding, enjoy an open-buffet lunch. Afterward, your exploration of Aswan begins with a visit to the <u>High Dam</u>, an iconic engineering feat crucial to Egypt's modern history, providing flood control and significant power since its completion.

Continuing the Aswan excursions, you'll visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, believed to have been commissioned by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> during the New Kingdom, located in the red granite quarries. Following this, a motorboat ride will take you to the breathtaking <u>Philae Temple</u> on Agilika Island, an ancient site central to the myth of Isis and Osiris. After concluding the Aswan tours, return to the Nile cruise boat for dinner and an overnight stay in Aswan.

Meals provided include lunch and dinner.

#### Day 2: from Edfu to visit the Kom-Ombo Temple

After a satisfying breakfast on the cruise ship, guests have the opportunity to opt for an additional tour to <u>Abu Simbel</u>. Following lunch, the Nile cruise sets sail for Kom Ombo. Upon arrival, visitors will explore the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, renowned historically for its association with the training of African elephants for military purposes. This temple venerates <u>Sobek</u>, the crocodile god, and Haroeris, a variant of Horus. The day concludes with the ship journeying to Edfu, where dinner will be served on board and guests will spend the night.

Meals provided include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

### Day 3: The Edfu Temple visit

Commence your day with a delectable breakfast aboard the MS Nile Radamis Nile River Cruise. Following breakfast, embark on a horse-drawn carriage ride through <u>Edfu</u> town to visit the <u>Temple of Horus</u>. After the tour, lunch will be served onboard. Enjoy afternoon tea as the vessel continues its journey towards Luxor. Upon arrival, overnight accommodation will be provided in Luxor.

In the evening, guests have the option to join an additional excursion to the <u>sound and light show at Karnak Temple.</u>

#### Day 4: A day Tour in Luxor East and West Bank

Begin the final day of your journey with a satisfying breakfast on board the cruise before check-out. Embark on a comprehensive Luxor day tour led by our expert guide, encompassing both the <u>East and West Banks</u>. Your exploration commences at the <u>Karnak Temples</u>, constructed over centuries by various pharaohs between 2200 and 360 B.C. Following this, visit the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, constructed between 1400 and 1000 B.C. during the powers of Pharaohs <u>Amenhotep III</u> and <u>Ramses II</u>.

Proceed to the West Bank for a visit to the Valley of the Kings, recognized for its numerous royal tombs. Originally known as "Ta Iset Maat," meaning "place of truth," this site holds immense historical significance. You will also discover the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, an architectural marvel by Senenmut dedicated to the pharaoh Hatshepsut, Egypt's most prominent female ruler. Additionally, observe the Colossi of Memnon. Upon concluding the tour, transfer to your preferred location in Luxor.

In the early morning, consider joining an optional excursion for <u>a hot air balloon ride</u> over Luxor.
